Old Blaze out letters B.T. Plainly visible, remainder of marking have obliterated.

Drove an iron pipe 60 ins. long for Corner 48 ins in the ground. Set 6" sq post alongside. New B.Ts.

W.O. 18" diam. bears S 79° E 34.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S. 523 C.S. B.T.
B.O. 20" " " N 49° W 50.0 " " 1/4 S. 514 C.S. B.T.

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N.W. Corner Isaac A Flint D.L.C. No 45

Position identified from fence as given in deed descriptions and bearings and distances from the south boundary of D.L.C. 45 and sec 23 & the 1/4 sec. Cor. on the North boundary of sec 23

All locatⁿ evidence of the original corner were destroyed in the construction of the old Nickel Mine road. The location selected satisfies the relationships given in the original field notes and present existing conditions. Drove an iron pipe 48" long

flush with ground in cutbank of Old Nickel Mine Road at or under an 8" B.O. which was marked N.W. Cor D.L.C. 45 C.S. B.T.

New bearing trees were blazed & scribed as follows:-

✓ Sec. Cor. Secs. 16, 17, 20, 21 Found ^{old} Stake scribed ⁹/₄ a pile of rocks set up for cor. from which found trees cut into ⁹/₄ which I

Scribed on bark 30" Pine S 20° W. 23', " S 20 T 30 S R 6 W - This tree was already blazed but burned in blaze. - 30" Pine which bears N 60° W 37' had been cut into ⁹/₄ found scribe marks showing distinctly - marked (with scribe) this tree on bark " S 17, T 30 S, R 6 W C.S. B.T.

30" Pine S 25° E 125', on 19° slope, blazed, marked this on bark " S 20, T 30 S, R 6 W C.S. B.T.

Blazed & scribed 16" Fir, on N. side Road, N 42 1/2° E 50.5' from cor. " S 16, T 30 S, R 6 W C.S. B.T. on bark For Corner Set railroad iron driven upright in rock pile + scribed 3" Fir on 4 sides

✓ Quarter sec. corner bet Sec's 17 & 20 - Drove a railroad iron here in a pile of rocks ⁹/₄ remarked original B.T.'s on bark.

✓ Sec Cor Sec's 17, 18, 19 & 20 Found the three O.B.T.'s but the one in S.W. Quadrant was gone ⁹/₄ stump only showing - marked new trees (2) 12" Pine S 50° W 31.0' ⁹/₄ a 12" Pine

N 30° W 41.0' - Set a 4x4 Post ⁹/₄ a pile rocks at corner - found a pile rocks abt 2' N. O.B.T. 30" Pine S 79° E 32.0' - 40" Pine N 81° 30' W 29.0' - 48" Pine Stump S 67° W 30.0' 8" Pine N 27 1/2° E 14.0' - Drove Post

✓ West 1/4 Cn Sec 17 - Cor bet 17 ⁹/₄ 18 - Found one ¹⁶/₄ Pine # N 85° W ^{23.4}/₄ (70 Lks) renewed scribe marks on bark - Marked new tree 20" Pine S 85° E 33' ⁹/₄ drove 4x4 Post.

✓ Quarter sec. corner bet. 16 & 17, Found Pile Rocks for cor. ⁹/₄ stump for O.B.T. to S.W. Found O.B.T. S 2° E 85.8' - renewed scribe marks on bark. Set 4x4 Post ⁹/₄ scribed new B.T. 30" Pine N 57° W 12'

✓ Cen Sec 17 - 4x4 Fir Post + Pile Rox fr. which 30" Fir brs N. 21°W 28.5 ft ^{9/2}
 20" Pine brs S 77°E 7.0. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 17 - $\frac{1305}{76W}$ c.s. B.T. set by intersecting both mid-sec. lines

✓ N.W. Cor. Sec 17 - Found Orig Laurel B.T. ^{to NE} ^{9/2} Pile of Rocks - Set 4x4 Cedar post ^{9/2} of pile of rocks for corner fr. which 16" Fir brs. S 41 1/2° W 7.5 ft, 12" Fir brs. N 78° W. 22.5 ft. 72" Fir (scribed on bark) brs N 53° E 34 ft, 15" Madrone brs S 57° E 17.0 ft.

✓ N 1/4 Cor Sec 17. Set. bet NW Cor + NE Cor, midway, set pile rox ^{9/2} cedar post from which 20" Fir brs. N 48° W 42.5 (on slope) ^{9/2} 15" Fir brs. S 60° W. 61.0'
 Note { Found a corner with 2 B.T's scribed, prob with knife, on bark abt 30' x ^{9/2} 45' W of corner as set: these trees prob. refer to mining claim cor. did not disturb it.

✓ N.E. Cor Sec 17. the orig. B.T's for this corner were found but not the 40" Fir recorded as N 8° W 19 L - for this tree marked a 40" fir N 8° W. 12 1/2 ft ^{9/2} scribed it - the 40" Ced "S 35 W 206 Links" actually is S 35 W. 118 ft, rescribed it. the 18" Pine S 40° E is as given or 61 = 92 L - ^{9/2} the 40" Fir shown as N 45° E 133 L is 93.0 ft rescribed this on the bark
