#13 ✓ 1/4 Corner bet 37+29. Set. Sq. Post from One OBT and stump of other. Marked. 48" Fir N23 1/2 W 30<sup>2</sup> ft; 12" Fir S9° E 40<sup>2</sup> ft.

✓ Section Corner, 29-30-31-32. Set from 7 OBTs. standing and 7 stumps set as per distances; Drove Iron Pipe; Marked 8" Fir S15 1/2 W 6° ft; 18" Cedar N30 1/2 W 46<sup>2</sup> ft; 18" Cedar S87 1/2 E 49<sup>2</sup> ft (OBT); 18" Fir S83° E 52<sup>2</sup> OBT.

✓ 1/4 Cor bet 29 & 30. Found 1 OBT, and 1 stump. Bearings check with field notes; except that trees are interchanged. One field note distance is given as 4 links, but checks with 40 links. Set sq. Post + marked 30" y. Pine S34° E 30<sup>2</sup> ft; 14" Cedar S15 1/2 W 43° ft.

✓ 1/4 Cor. Bet 20 & 29. Found 7 OBTs, one rotted and other one burned off. Set Iron Pin from OBTs and marked. 24" Fir S10° W 42<sup>2</sup> ft 20" Cedar N12 1/2 W 31<sup>6</sup> ft.

✓ Sec. Cor. 20-21-28-29. Set from one OBT, and one stump others gone. Set Post; marked 36" Fir N5° E 46<sup>3</sup> ft; 10" yew S47 1/2 E 71<sup>6</sup> ft; 36" Fir S84° W 12° ft; 30" Fir N45° W 72<sup>2</sup> ft.

✓ 1/4 Cor. bet. 28 & 29. Set midway between section corners, as all signs of trees gone; Drove Pipe + marked 18" Cedar N43 1/2 W 59<sup>5</sup> ft 24" Cedar S63° W 144<sup>2</sup> ft.

✓ Section Corner common to Sec's 11, 12, 13 + 14,  
One old BT. standing now a 60" Fir 57° E 29<sup>2</sup> ft.  
Another Fir N17° W 23<sup>2</sup> ft. probably recorded as BT but not marked, Rotten alder stump N80° E 52.1 ft. checks with field notes.

Set post for corner with BTs as follows.  
60" Fir 57° E 29<sup>2</sup> ft. OBT  
60" " N17° W 23<sup>2</sup> "  
18" Hemlock S63° W 103°  
60" Fir N19° E 70<sup>3</sup>

1/4 Sec. Cor. between Secs. 12 & 13.  
Identified by one O.B.T. properly marked. Original notes call for two Firs. Found one Hemlock. N80°W 20kts.  
Set Post for corner. New BTs.  
10" Yew N83°W 20<sup>3</sup>ft.  
15" Cedar S69°W 56<sup>8</sup>ft.

1/4 Sec. Cor between Secs. 13 & 14.  
Identified by old Hemlock Stump carrying scribe marks and a 36" Fir which bears proper scars which I did not chop out.  
Set post for corner and marked a  
10" Hemlock S54°10'W 11<sup>3</sup>ft. and remarked O.B.T. 36" leaning Fir N35°E 36<sup>6</sup>ft.

1/4 Sec. Cor. between Secs. 22 and 23  
Location identified by Laurel BT which on being chopped out showed original scribe marks. Also hole where other recorded BT. stood.  
Set 6"x6"x48" Yew wood post, scribed 1/4S 23 on E face 1/4S 22 on W face, and CS on S face, for corner.  
O.B.T. 16" Laurel S88°E 32kts.  
New BT 32" Fir N10°22'E 46<sup>5</sup>lks bark scribed 1/4S23 CS BT.  
" 36" Fir N81°20'W 55<sup>1</sup>lks scribed 1/4S22 CS BT.
