Meander Corner, Secs. 10 and 11.

Found - Orig. 36" Fir stump BT for MC at 71.02 chs. and from it relocated the M.C. as the Spruce tree is missing.

Set - 1 1/2" I.P. and 3"x3"x4' Post from which bears:

BT's - 36" Orig. Fir stump N.21°W., 26.4 ft. to nail in bark between scribe marks S R 12 W and 26.8 ft. to nail in wood above old springboard hole.

18" Hemlock across Harmony Bay bears S.15°30'E.

Found - a 6"x6"x3' Post scribed C.S. M.C. on the bank near the fir BT. evidently removed from correct position and laid there to protect it from high water as the I.P. now stands 2 ft. above water level.

The M.C. at 77.00 chains is missing as the bulb farmer has cleared the land of all stumps & brush. This corner comes to W. of his boathouse.

Left 1 1/2" Pipe under boathouse in case corner could be located at later date.

Section Corner for Secs. 27,28,33 and 34.

Found - Two BT's at the corner and from them relocated corner.

Set - 1 1/2" I.P. from which bears:

48" Spruce snag S.84°W., 52.8 ft. All marks covered if any are there. Cruiser's marks Y X on N & W side.

Orig. 48" Spruce stump S.11°E., 34.98 ft. scribed BT. Rest of inscription covered.

Orig. 48" Spruce N.72°W., 66 ft. showing are marks. Now lies across gulch bearing N.E. There has been a slide where it once stood.

Orig. 24" Spruce N.22°E., 35.64 ft. Has fallen over and rotted away. Only small chunks remain.

I mkd: a 12" Spruce N.43°E., 16.6 ft. to nail BT. S27 with crayon
12/11/41

1/4 Corner for Secs. 22 and 27.

Chained West from M.C. and at 2675.6 ft. arrived at a point where we relocated the 1/4 corner from a 24" Spruce stump which we took to be orig. 24" Spruce BT. This is a stump of old snag which was blazed and marked with one axe notch like the BT at M.C.

Set - 2"x2"x6' Spruce limb for 1/4 Corner S.22-S27 W.C. Corbitt, 1943,
From which Bears:

Orig. 24" Spruce stump N.45°W., 198 ft. nail in notch.

6 ft. Spruce stump N.7°E., 22.2 ft. blazed crayon mark S22 RP BT

4 ft. Spruce stump S.7°W., 34.2 ft. blazed crayon mark S27 RP BT.

Corner is 33 East of Cat Road on Ridge.

3/22/43

1/4 Corner, Secs. 21 and 22.

Jan. 10, 1941, P. Krugur & N. Seethoff had no field notes when they found 50" Fir with scribe marks on bark on old stake marked 1/4 Corner with crayon is on South side of Sharp Ridge running E. & W.

Set - 1 1/2" I.P. on So. side of stake from which bears:

50" Fir, S.54°W., 8.5 ft.

Nov. 5, 1941, W.G. Corbitt and Barney Senn found stake, pipe and Fir tree described by Krugur. I put nail in S. mark and took bearing from pipe which is S.53°W., 8.5 ft. The scribe marks visible are S /4 S, Cruisers marks. NE Fir tree has fresh blaze on North side. I found a 6" Cascara tree on North side of ridge about 30 ft. from I.P. It had scars on trunk but no visible axe or scribe marks. This pipe is about 300 ft. W. of main N. & S. Ridge. May 3, 1943, W. G. Corbitt left 1 1/2" I.P. in top of 4 ft. Spruce stump blazed on N. & S. Sides and X on S. Side. This stands south of swamp at about 72.00 chains.

1941-43

Section Corner For Sec. 9 10, 16 and 15.

Found - Iron marks on Root of 60" Spruce., N.26°E., 21.0 ft.

Iron Marks found on 40" Spruce S.8°E., 26.5 ft.

I did not have orig. notes.

Set - 1 1/2" I.P. 1/2 ft. protruding next to the stake found. Iron marks face the stake.

Many large Spruce about close to the stake. Stake is in the lowest place at the head of a small ravine. Cruisers marks, E.J.
