Location identified from an old post bearing scribe marks lying on the ground and a cedar 28 inches diam. S. 75°E. 27.1 ft. which has

been blazed and scribed by some previous surveyor. I found the

rotted stumps of a Hemlock and a Cedar which checked for bearing

and distance with those shown in the original records of the

government survey. No scribe marks were visible on these old stumps.

Set an iron bar, 1/2 x 2 inches 36 inches long, 24 inches in the

ground for the corner. Drove a Yewwood post alongside scribed DLC 7 CS.

Remarked the 28 inch Cedar S. 75°E. 27.1 ft. and marked a new B.T.,

a Cedar 24 inches diam. N. 42°W. 59.1 ft.
