Stump N.65°E. 17.2 ft. Cut too low to find scars or scribing.
No trace of S.W. BT.
New BT: 17" D. Fir S.62 1/2°W. 67.8-ft. mkd: T21S R7W CC S2 CS BT.
Haines has rescribed 30" Fir S.6°E. 27.7 ft. "S 1 BT" in bark.

Found - Haines' "T" Iron and cap at Corner. - *REN. #12*
Maple, now 24", N.33°E. 25.1 ft., reverse scribing visible on wood grown against old face. Tree hollow & one side rotted.
White Fir, now 40", N.60°W. 18.5 ft., hollow & S.E. side rotted away. No scribing seen.
No trace of Fir Bearing Tree to S. E.
Remnant of Cedar Stump S. 9°W. 32.3 feet, apparently one of Wheeler's Trees, 1883 survey.
New BT's: 31" D.Fir N.20°W. 38.5 ft. Mkd: T21S R7W S33 CS BT.
16" D.Fir N.54°E. 66.9 ft. Mkd: T21S R7W S34 CS BT.

Closing Corner to S4/S3 T22S R7W 64
Found - Haines' "T" Iron & Cap. - Fir, now 64", S.20°E. 37.6 ft., cut open & found good scribing "S" on old face.
Dogwood, down & badly rotted, S.42°W. 41.6 ft. Found, but wood but center rotted away. No scribing or old face found
New BT's: 64" D.Fir S.20°E. 37.6 ft. Mkd: T22S R7W CC S3 CS BT (rescribed in wood)
12" R.Cedar S.17°W. 41.8 ft. Mkd: T22S R7W S 4 CC CS BT.

RE-RENEWED CORNER NO. #103
