The B. T. is standing with 2 blades, but no marks, which prob-
ably were cut out.

Two other B. T. were lying down, but plainly marked, so I
remark the old original 3 W. B. T. no other trees within limits.

Set a fir post, from which a fir 60" diam bears N 10° E
80 lks distant.

A fir 20" diam bears S 23° W 17 1/2 lks distant. 35; #20

both original B. T. are still standing, but killed by fire
years ago, liable to fall.

Set 1" galv. iron pipe with a brass cap mkd. C. S. T 22
R 5 W. 1/4 8-9, from which

15" Chinquapin bears N 30° E 195.4 ft.
White Oak, O. B. T. bears S 30° E 25.7 ft.

Drove an iron rod 5/8 inches X 30 inches. - See Rev. #17 8/9
Only one B. T. remained, a Cedar stub, I established 3 additional 19

B. Ts. as follows:

A Cedar, 8 inches in Dia., which bears North 58° West, 32.8 feet.

A Maple, 22 inches in Diameter, which bears North 57° 30' East, 71.0 feet
dist.

A Maple, 24 inches in Dia. which bears South 72° 20' East, 72.0
feet, dist.

1/4 sec. corner to secs. 8 and 9.

1/2 inch bolt at corner.

Found 1 Fir B. T. 60 inches in Dia. remaining, but all scribe had #35
been burned out, however this tree is North 10° West, not North 10° East
as described in the notes. Bert Cutlack was present and he was also #20
present almost exactly 50 years ago when the re-survey was made and
has lived in the immediate vicinity ever since. He stated that this Fir
had always been considered the B. T.

I scribed:

A Madrone, 1 1/2 inches in Dia. which bears North 61° 30' East, 87.0
feet dist.

North corner common to secs. 8 and 9.

B. T. OK, Stake badly rotted;

Set iron rod 5/8 inches X 26 inches in its place. 37 21
