 or scribing found, (Thiel's Tree).

 gone to find scars or scribing.

 & found scribing "AS".
 No trace of S.W. BT.

 New BT's: 8" R. Cedar S.88°W. 36.2 ft. Mkd: 1/2 S3 CS BT.
 Blaze & Rescribe 30" R. Cedar N.7°E. 30.3 ft. 1/2 S2 CS BT.
 Top of scribing 6 ft. above ground, log lies against old face.
 Note - Corner Monument is under East end of Fir Log, 48" diam.

 log lying on ground. Scar on Stump.

 N.W. Tree. Old axe mka. visible in bark above log,
 rescribed this tree, in bark, above log, T22S RAW S3 CS BT.
