March 27, 1899. In presence of Frank Kent, Arthur Rhodes, dead  
snag of original B.T. standing; part of letters visible. **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 65 1**

1/4 sec. cor. betw. 7 and 8  
Set a willow post from which a fir 12" diam. bears N 9° W.  
83 lks distant.  
A fir 50" diam. bears S 85° E 21 lks distant.  
October 30, 1899. In presence of Levic Kent, John Haskins,  
James Haskins. S.W. original tree fallen down, letters still visible,  
the other B.T. remains, but marks burnt off. **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 20 2**

Corner of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.  
Set a post, from which a cedar 10" dia. bears N. 28°  
44 lks distant.  
A cedar 16" dia bears S W. 27° W. 200 lks distant.  
A maple 20" dia bears S 26° W 66 lks distant.  
A fir 28" dia. bears S 13° E 87 lks distant.  
Feb. 24, 1900. Present Levi Hunt, B. Ross, J. W. Dunbar;  
all original B. T. been cut down, but marks on two stumps still  
visible. **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 210 3**

A white oak 6" dia. bears S 41° W 83 lks distant.  
A white oak 6" dia. bears N. 52 1/2° W 90 lks distant.  
A black oak 10" dia. bears N. 54° W 409 lks distant.  
All the original B.T. have been cut down, marks were found on three  
of the remaining stumps, all agreeing in direction and distance  
with the standard lines. Present, Lee Barker and John Pegles.

1/4 secs. cor. bet. secs. 32 and 33. # 152  
Set a maple post, the WE B.T. has been cut down but the  
B.T. is plain on stump, and corresponding to description in origi-  
nal field notes the N. W. tree is entirely gone, from which,  
A maple 5" diam. bears S 36° W. 62 lks distant.  
A maple 7" diam bears S 69° E 81 lks distant.  
June 27, 1900. Present. Ernest and Herman Thiel. **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 5**

1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 33 and 34 .  
Set a fir post, from which white oak 12 ins diam. bears N 45° E.  
75 lks. dist.  
from which blackoak 32 ins diam bears S 43° W. # 104  
16 lks. dist. **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 6**  
June 27, 1900. Present. Ernest and Herman Thiel.  
The N. E. B. T. having been cut down for fence but by cutting  
in stump I find original marks , S W. B.T. being badly decayed  
where it was originally marked, but the tree being vigerous I  
remarked same.

Reestablishment of the sec. cor. between 31 & 32  
& sec 5 & 6, T 23 - 5 (Not a common corner)  
Fd. Rock set By Thiel (apparently) From O. B. T. #28A **RE-RENEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 7**
