Found - 45" D. Fir S. 55° E. 18.5 ft., uprooted & down, bark scribing visible " $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT".
24" Fir Stump S. 55° W. 19.8 ft., chopped open & found bottom edge of aze scar, 75-80 yrs. old. Tree cut too low to find scrbng.

$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner common to Sections 10 and 11.
Found - Rock set by Eppstein or Cole, lying on top of ground at old fence corner; markings found on Rock. REN. #8
Old Fir Stump S. 54° E. 116.8 ft.; stump decaying badly, no bark left; no scribing found.
No trace of S. W. Bearing Tree.
Reset - Rock 4" x 5" x 26", 16" in ground at fence corner.
Rock Mkd: " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on N. face, "S10" on W. face, & "S11" on E. face.
(I mark "x" on top end of Rock.)
New BT's: 20" D. Fir S. 7° E. 58.5 ft. Mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S11 CS BT.
18" D. Fir S. 18° W. 73.5 ft. Mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 CS BT.
Note - Both BT's. lie on opposite side of Paradise Creek from corner.
Corner is in fence line along N. side of Paradise Creek. Fence from South corners with E. & W. Fence at $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner.

Section Corner to Sections 2 - 3 - 10 - 11.
Found - 12" x 12" x 16" Rock set by Cole, 1915. No other rocks in immediate vicinity. No marks found on rock. REN. #9
Stump Hole & rotten remnants of Fir Stump N. 36° W. 28.4 ft.
Slight depression, could be Stump Hole, N. 50° E. 29.7 ft.
Slight depression, could be stump hole, S. 23° E. 33.0 ft.
No trace of S.W. BT., location falls in roadway.
Cole's notes state that stumps were all that was left of BT's. in 1915.
Yellow tag on fence post 48 ft. E. of Rock, stating that Sec. Corner was 48 ft. West of tag.

Found - Partly rotted old Fir Snag N. 70° W. 15.8 ft. (to face) Cut open & found good scribing "S11 T22S R8W BT".
Burned remains of old Fir Stump S. 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 59.4 ft. Too far gone to find scars or scribing.
No trace of N.E. or S.E. BT's. found.
Small gully running N.W. 55 lks. E. of corner checks call in Gov't notes.

Found - Rock, 6" x 8" x 12", set by Germond, 1916. FD. chiseled "X" on top of Rock.
No trace of either tree marked by Germond. (BTs described in #55 were for 1/4 Cor.)
40" Fir S. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 208 ft. (to face), bark scribing, looks like Thiel's.
Down & badly decayed Oak S. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 222 ft., no markings. Last 2 trees mentioned fit bearing & distance of 2 Original Bearing Trees.
