1/4 Section Corner to Sections 18 & 19.
Scribed - 8" Alder S.18°E. 7.7 ft.
6" Alder N.63°E. 8.7 ft.
Drove 1"x 1"x 36" Iron Rod in ground, attached brass cap
inscribed "Wilford N. Haines, Survey Pt., #239."

Section Corner to Sections 13, 18, 19, & 24. T22S R9W - T22S R10W
Found - Original Corner & all BT's. are standing.
Drove 1"x 1"x 36" Iron Rod in ground.

West 1/4 Section 4.
At this corner set a 4" Fir Limb Post Mkd. 1/4 S 4, P.S. 253 from which:
A Fir 24" bears N.46°E. 56.9 feet.
A Root of a 60" Fir bears S.35°E. 4.1 feet.

North 1/4 Section 4.
At this corner set a 4" Fir Post Mkd. 1/4 S 4 from which: added 4/6/02 AD
A Fir 40" diam, bears S.57°E., 87.0 feet, MKD: V4 S4 PS 253 BT

Center 1/4 Corner of Section 4.
At this corner, I set a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe & a 4" Hemlock Post Mkd. 1/4 S 4 from which:
A Dead Fir 24" diam, bears N.72°E. 55.6 feet, MKD: V4 S4 PS 253 BT.
A Fir Stump 48" diam, bears S.29 1/2°W. 26.8 feet, MKD: V4 S4 PS 253 BT
added 4/6/02 AD

Closing Corner to Sec. 5 and Sec. 4
Found - 14 X 12 X 6" sand stone, CC marked on one side, 2 grooves on one side,
stone badly weathered and laying on surface
From Which: A Fir, 26 (now 39) inches dia. bears N20 1/2°E, 27.7 ft. Scribed
"C C T22S R9W S" Blaze partially opened and burned.
A fir stump, 28 (39) inches dia. bears S 71 1/2°E, 69.7 ft. (rec. 68°ft). Partial
blaze below cutting line scribed "BT" (Blaze not Orig. as face of blaze
face of blaze falls well outside of record diameter).
A fir 8 (now 35) inch dia. bears S 53 1/2°W, 115.5 ft. (rec. S 52PW). Tree has
good blaze. T21S R9W S32
