with GLO plat of 1896 by Pershin, which shows the North line of
section 17 to jog. I scribe the following BT's -
10" D. Fir bears S.29°W., 10.3 ft.
8" Maple bears N.62°E., 47.1 ft.

Set - 5/8" Iron rod at center 1/4 corner
From which I scribe:
20" D. Fir bears N.49°E., 48.5 ft.
12" Alder bears S.43°E., 22.7 ft.

Set - Brass cap mkd. T22S R9W WM 10, 11, 14, 15 1977
From which:

60" D. Fir orig. BT, now 7 ft. dia. burned out hole with stubs and
old USGLO location poster bears S.76°E., 25.7 ft.
16" D. Fir orig. BT now 52" with old face, old "X" and scars bears
S.59°W., 151.8 ft. (Rec. S.48 1/2°W., 145.9 ft.)
36" D. Fir orig. BT, now big stub bears N.39°E., 151.7 ft. (Rec.
N.45°E., 132.0 ft.)

Above evidence noted by Haines in May 16, 1967, I concur.

52" D. Fir orig. BT, I rescribe "T22S R9W S15 BT" bears S.59°W.,
151.8 ft.
24" D. Fir, I scribe "T22S R9W S10 BT" bears N.47°W., 62.5 ft.
22" D. Fir I scribe "T22S R9W S11 BT" bears N.24°E., 27.0 ft.
28" D. Fir I scribe "T22S R9W S14 BT" bears S.73°E., 67.2 ft.

24" D. Fir, I scribe "T22S R9W NWC DLC 44 BT" bears S.71°W., 11.5 ft.
22" D. Fir I scribe "T22S R9W NWC DLC 44 BT" bears S.82°E., 57.0 ft.

Original BT's gone. Area on probable slide 70-80 years old.

Set - Brass cap mkd. T22S R9W WM NEC DLC No. 43 DLC No. 44 1977
From which:

48" Maple, I scribe "T22S R9W NEC DLC 43 BT" bears N.78°W., 6.7 ft.
12" Oak, I scribe "T22S R9W NEC DLC 43 BT" bears North, 132.4 ft.
Ancient fence line bears N & S with old fence line bearing W.

Statement: "I, Floyd V. Weatherly, and my family, have owned the property
adjacent to and east of above corner for 90 years. These property lines and
corner have been accepted as the location of the NE corner of DLC #43 for

Found - I found a 60 to 80 yr. old 1 1/2" I.P. driven in bed of Bruchard
Creek that closely matches call of Oreg. State Hwy. R/W map of
1933: We verified this with transit survey. Pipe also matches
orig. calls for creek in DLC No. 43 notes. Lying over the 1 1/2"
pipe is an 18" x 23" x 36" rock. I MARKED an "X" directly over
the pipe

A very old D. Fir stump 34" bears S.70°E., 51.0 ft. (Rec. 66.7 ft.)
No scribes found.
A very old badly decayed D. Fir stump, 18" more or less, (Rec. 12")
bears N.76°E., (Rec. N.89°E.,) 65.4 ft. (Rec. 62.5 ft.) No scribes
found.
48" Maple, I scribed, "NWC DLC 43 BT" bears N.52°E., 50.0 ft.
12" Alder, I bark scribed "T22S R9W NWC DLC 43 BT" bears N.36°W
27.7 ft.
