- 4" Fir bears N.30°E. 50 lks; now 11", face grown over, found to be 50 ft. instead of 50 lks.
- 4" Fir bears S.12°E. 15 lks.; now 11", face grown over.
- 4" Fir bears S.45°W. 20 lks.; now 12", exposed scribe R, found to be 20 ft. distance instead of 2.0 lks.
- 20" Fir bears N.68°W. 75 lks.; now 36" windfall face grown over, found stump hole to be 75 ft. distance, not 75 lks.
