$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner common for Section 34, (South Side).
Orig: 20" x 16" x 12" Stone (found in place, $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. Face) from which:
8" Maple bears S.20°E. 30 lks.; now missing, group of small
maples growing in place.
10" Fir bears N.52°W. 50 lks.; now rotten stump.
Restored: Set - 4 x 4 x 72" Wh. painted Cedar Post 2.0 ft. S.W. of
corner stone, from which a:
28" Fir bears N.25 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W. 39.6 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT RS359
18" Fir bears N.46°E. 54.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.

Closing Section Corner common to Secs. 3 & 4, T23S, R10W.
Orig: Fir Post, now missing, from which a:
12" Hemlock bears S.59°E. 40 lks.; now down, scribes T2S R10 S3 vis.
7" Fir bears S.81°W. 22 lks.; rotten root crown in place.
Restored: Set - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" Gal. I.P. with 3" br. cap mkd: "Ore.St.Bd. of
Forestry S34 T22S R10W S4 S3 CC T23S R10W 1962 RS359",
30" in ground, from which a:
24" Fir bears S.80 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E. 23.1 ft.; scribed CC T23S R10W S3 BT RS359.
20" Hemlock bears S.32°W. 32.5 ft.; scribed CC T23S R10 W S4 BT.
Ore.St.Forestry Dept. metal location poster on 24" Fir BT.
Set 4" x 4" x 72" painted white Cedar Post 1.0 ft. SW of corner pipe.
Original Line blaze on 26" Hemloc, South 16.7 ft.

Section Corner common to Sections 33 and 34.
Orig: 80" x 20" x 6" Stone (called 20" x 6" x 6" by L.C.Walker retrmt.
in 1906) (found 4" x 11" x 12" stone with 3 notches on side,
stoned rolled down hill out of place) from which a:
40" Fir bears N.42°E. 12 lks.; 40" snag bears N.15°E. 12 lks.
8" Fir bears S.55°W. 17 lks.; now 30", face closed.
6" Alder bears N.42°W. 14 lks.; now missing.
Also found uprooted 16" Tree mkd. originally for cor. 33 & 34 with
scribing said to have been obliterated when above corner was set.
This tree is 2.14 ch. East of above corner as called for in
retracement by L. C. Walker.
Restored: Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" gal. iron pipe with 3" br. cap mkd: "Ore. St.
Bd. of Forestry T22S R10W S33 S34 T23S R10W S4 1962 RS359",
30" in gr. with orig. stone alongside, in mound of stone,

22" Fir bears N.62°W. 122.1 ft.; scribed T22SR10 W S33 BT.
16" Fir bears N.32°E. 17.8 ft.; scribed T22S R10W S34 BT RS359
Ore. St. Forestry Dept. metal location poster on 16" Fir BT.
Set 4" x 4" x 72" Wh. painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. S.E. of corner pipe.

Original - 18"x14"x10" Sandstone, (in place, $\frac{1}{4}$ S visible) from which a:
6" Alder bears S.2W 150 lks.; now missing.
30" Fir bears East 68 lks.; niw 46", scribes 4S visible.
Restored - Set - 4"x4"x72" White painted Cedar Post 1.0 ft. NW of
Corner Stone, from which a:
36" Fir bears N6W 49.9 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT RS359.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 36" Fir BT.

Sec. Corner to Secs. 23 - 24 - 25 - 26.
Found - Orig. Stone 3"x14"x28" (missing)
6" Fir bears N.88°E. 43 lks., now 22", face visible, no scribes.
Retracement by A.Todd, 1894 (no other trees added: Steep south slope
bears W. (& line of orig. blazes). Divide bears S.660.0 lks.; in place.
Foot of bluff bears S.15 lks.; in place. Orig. & Retracement line blzs. S.
Restored: Scribed X in bedrock on top of bluff, in mound of rock;
16" Fir bears N.40°W. 11.2 ft.; scribed T22S R10W S23 BT.
16" Fir bears N.26 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E. 20.5 ft.; scribed T22S R10W S24 BT.
22" Fir (Orig.) bears N.88°E. 28.4 ft.; scribed RS 359.
14" Fir bears S.61 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W. 3.0 ft.; scribed T22S R10W S26 BT.
3' x 10' Rock Face bears S.66 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E. 6.9 ft.; scribed X BO.
