Meander corner, Secs. 23 and 24. Left Bank
Found - 1961 County brass cap, 1 1/2 ft. below ground surface. Ren. #20
16" Dogwood (Byron's rec. "maple") bears S.62°E., 48.8 ft. healed
face.
SW maple BT (triple trunk) the scribed section of tree found up-
rooted and fallen toward river. The second trunk is dead
remaining trunk is live.
New BT - 33" maple (remaining live trunk) bears S.78°W., 44.2 ft. scribed
T22S R10W S23 MC CS BT.
Location - From Scottsburg Park entrance go west on Hwy. #38 0.6 miles to
location poster on Maple, north of Hwy. Corner lies N.20°W., approx. 200 ft.
Attention sign at corner site (cap buried 1 1/2 ft. below ground surface)
Second location poster on piece of snag, from which corner lies 1.0 ft.
south. Distances are to side and center of trees at root crown.

Section corner for Secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12
Found - 15" D. fir stump, 1 ft. high with center rotten bears N.50°E.,
6.63 ft. The stump was cut about two years ago has remains of
a small flat face with axe marks visible behind a partially
rehealed face that was cut out. Counted 41 growth rings to face.
The snag was over 73 years old and I also compared it with the
found orig. 15" D. fir BT for the W 1/4 of Sec. 11, which was
set at the same time. After establishing the corner point I
ran a loop traverse between sections 1 and 2 and also tied the
sec. corner to 35 and 36, T21S R10W so I could compare calls &
distances with GLO notes (Rec. dist. 6177.6 ft., measured
6089.02 ft.) The GLO calls for two definite points from the
north, one call for two creeks 52.8 ft. apart and another call
1029.6 ft. from the corner, "along W. slope and then along E.
slope, divide course S.80°W., Those check good. On the south
it calls for a divide course NW, but the only divide is
about 1000 ft. away, but we have a spur 140 ft. south of the
corner (GLO call 82.5 ft.) Calls going west to the 1/4 location
fit reasonably well. I met on the ground with Douglas County
remonumentation crew and Harvey Wofford, Land Surveyor from
BLM, Coos Bay to evaluate all the evidence found; a comment by
Harvey was that he would hold to the evidence over proportional
measurement. 4/6/82 met with Doug. Co. remonumentation crew.
3/29/82 met with Harvey Wofford, BLM Land Surveyor. (statement
letter attached to C.S. file notes.)

Set - Douglas County brass cap on 3/4" I.P. 36" long with flanged
bottom. Cap is marked: T22S R10W S2 S1 S11 S12 1982.
New BT;s 34" D. fir stump bears N.68°W., 72.5 ft. scribed T22S R10W S2
CS BT with 120 penny nail driven into top center, stamped B0.
30" D. fir stump bears S.30°W., 138.3 ft. scribed T22S R10W S11
CS BT with 120 penny nail driven into top center stamped B0.
31" D. fir stump bears S.9°E., 176.8 ft. scribed T22S R10W S12
CS BT with 120 penny nail driven into top center stamped B0.
Location: Go along Rd. #210 approx. 1.4 miles. Corner area is ribboned and
visible in large clearcut south of road. Location poster on
Hemlock on north bank of road. From poster, corner lies south 625'
Distances are to center of stumps.

Fnd - 50" fir bears S.22°45'W., 25.6-ft. (opened to scribing).
48" stump bears S.61°40'E., 38.6-ft.
48" snag bears N.40°30'W., 13.5-ft.
Set - I.P. with Brass Cap mkd: S12 & 13 T22S R10W.

Set - I.P. with B.C. mkd: S7 & S18 T22S R9W.
New BTs - 20" fir bears N.37°E., 26.0-ft.
22" fir bears N.60°W., 7.4-ft.
14" fir bears S44°E., 12.4-ft.

Set - Brass Cap in rock ledge mkd: 1/4 S12 T22S R10W.
New BTs - 24" alder bears S41°W., 55.5-ft.
30" fir bears S.61°E., 32.5-ft.
