Section Corner common to Secs. 11 - 12 - 13 - 14. 43
Orig: Stone 12"x10"x5" (missing, area now bare rock) from which:
8" Fir bears N.15°E. 36 lks.; now 16", orig. face overgrown,
cut through Orig. face also overgrown. #150
12" Fir bears S.29°E. 100 lks.; now 38", faces overgrown (bearing S.39°E.
12" Alder bears S.80°W. 60 lks.; now missing, point falls in slide area.
24" Alder bears N.52°W. 73 lks.; now missing, point covered by slide.
Bottom of gulch, course NE, bears West 1 ch.; now in place.
Bottom of gulch, course NE, bears North 2.16 chains; now in place.
Restored: Scribed X on bedrock for corner point from which:
13" Cedar bears S.69½°W. 32 ft.; scribed T22S R11W S14 BT.
10" Cedar bears N.33½°W. 42.9 ft.; scribed T22S R11W S11 BT RS359.
30 ft. by 5 ft. high rock ledge bears S.45°E. 11.4 ft.; scribed X B0.
Ore. St. Bd. of Forestry metal location poster on 10" Cedar BT.

Section Corner common to Sections 19 - 20 - 29 - 30 44
Orig: Stone 12"x10"x8" (now missing) from which a:
4" Chittum bears N.87°E. 18 lks.; now missing, uproot hole in place.
40" Fir bears S.54°E. 32 lks.; now 61", scribes S2 visible.
50" Fir bears S.56°W. 64 lks.; now 70", scribes S30 visible.
Restored: Set 1½" x 36" gal. iron pipe with 3" bronze cap Mkd. & from which:
21" Alder bears N 7¼°W. 37.3 ft.; scribed in bark T22S R11W S19 BT.
Orig. 40" Fir bears S.54°E. 21.1 ft.; scribed BT (near bottom).
Orig. 50" Fir bears S.56°W. 42.2 ft.; scribed RS359 BT (near bottom).
No other Trees available.
Ore. St. Bd. of Forestry metal location poster on Orig. 40" Fir BT.
Set 4" x 4" x 6' white painted Cedar Post 2.0 ft. South Corner Pipe.

¼ Corner to Sections 19 and 30. 45
Orig. - Post, found rotten remains, from which a:
12" Chittum bears S.12°W. 27 lks.; now uprooted 14" log, with
6" Chittum growing from same log 10 ft. from butt. #171
6" Vine Maple bears N.72°W. 85 lks.; 12" vine maple clump in place
Creek bears East 195 lks.; now in place. - Top of ridge bears West
230 lks.; now in place. - Orig. Line blaze approx. 4 chsn. W.
Rest. - Set 1½" x 36" Gal. iron pipe with 3" br. cap mkd: "Oregon State
Bd. of Forestry ¼ S19 S30 1961 RS359", 33" in gr., & from which a:
34" Cedar bears N.78°W. 75.5 ft.; scribed ¼ S19 BT RS359.
48" Cedar bears S.58°W. 71.4 ft.; scribed ¼ S30 BT.
Ore. St. Forstry Dept. metal location poster on 6" Chittum, S.8°W., 6.0 ft.
Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar Post 1 ft. SE of pipe.

¼ Corner to Sections 19 and 20. 46
Orig - 1894 - Stone 14"x10"x5", now missing, from which a:
14" Alder bears N.10°E. 14 lks.; now rotten stub 2' high. #173
24" Alder bears N.5°W. 29 lks.; now 30" stub 6' high evidence of
old face in bark & in rotted wood.
Stream bears South 200 lks.; in place - 1894 Line blazes bear N.100 lks.
Restored - Set 1½" x 36" Gal. iron pipe with 3" br. cap mkd: & 132 lks.
"OREGON STATE BD. OF FORESTRY ¼ S19 S20 1961 RS359", 33" in gr.,
in mound of stone, and from which a:
20" Cedar bears N.49°W. 23.9 ft.; scribed ¼ S19 BT RS 359.
24" Cedar bears N.82°E. 63.9 ft.; scribed ¼ S20 BT.
Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar Post 1' NE of pipe.

¼ Corner common to Sections 18 and 19. 47
Orig. - No evidence of original corner found. #169
Re-established - Set 1½" x 36" gl. iron pipe with 3" br. cap Mkd: "ORE. ST.
BOARD OF FORESTRY ¼ S18 S19 1961 RS359", 32" in gr., & from which a:
18" Hemlock bears S.25°E. 16.3 ft.; scribed ¼ S19 BT RS359.
26" Hemlock bears N.67°E. 40.5 ft.; scribed ¼ S18 BT.
Ore. St. Forestry Dept. metal location poster on 4" Hemlock S11°E. 6.4 ft.
Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. SE of pipe.
