Found - Orig. 6" Cherry (Missing) from which a:
18" Fir bears N. 85°W. 40 lks.; now 50" windfall, exposed scribes.
8" Myrtle bears N. 11°E. 22 lks.; now 20" in clump of 9, inside
honeycombed, axework visible.
Spur top bears N. 60 lks.; in place.
