Section Corner for Sections 17 - 18 - 19 - 20.
Placed Steel Axle in ground at location of old Corner,
as located and preserved by John F. Woodard.

New BT's: 6" Alder bears N. 04° E. 2.0 ft. Mkd: S17 BT
6" Alder bears N75° W. 14.2 ft. Mkd: S18 BT
8" Alder bears S. 45° W. 14.9 ft. Mkd: S19 BT
6" Alder bears S. 54° E. 21.5 ft. Mkd: S20 BT

20

1/4 Corner to Sections 20 and 21.
Found - Stake in stump on Hemlock Tree previously marked for
Corner, scribing visible in said stump.

Marked New BT's: 16" Hemlock bears N. 75° E. 22.5 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S BT.
8" Cedar bears S. 73° E. 90.0 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S BT.
No other tree available.

21

1/4 Corner between Sections 21 and 22.
This corner is 100 feet East of rock quarry and approx.
60 feet above logging road on north side.

New BT's: 18" D. Fir bears S. 11° E. 7.8 ft., mkd. 1/4 S BT.
(Orig. SE BT cut, now 38" stump)
10" Incense Cedar bears N. 41° W. 39.2 feet.

1/4 Corner between Sections 29 and 30.
39.0 feet North 75° East from yellow tag on Bearing
Stump to 38" Doug. Fir Stump and 48" Cedar Stump bears
South 88° West 53.0 feet.

Section Corner to Sections 29 - 30 - 31 - 32.
S. W. Hemlock BT., chopped out, scribe plainly visible.
Cedar & N.E. Hemlock located. Hemlock still standing,
but nearly dead; bears visible scar.

New BT's. Mkd: 16" Cedar bears N. 74° W. 52.5 ft. Mkd S30BT
32" Cedar bears S. 28° W. 65.0 ft. mkd S32BT
18" Hemlock brs. 30° W. 51.4 ft., mkd S31BT
20" Cedar bears N. 27° E. 80.5 ft.

1/4 Corner to Sections 31 and 32.
Rescribed Orig. 15" Doug. Fir 6.6 ft. East of Corner.
50" Doug. Fir bears S. 28° W. 18.0 feet.

1/4 Corner between Sections 29 and 32.
Stump of tree marked for corner has yellow tags set
by J. F. Woodard. Remarked Stump: 1/4 BT.

Sec. Cor. to Secs. 18 & 19, T23-3W. & Secs. 13 & 24, T23-4W:
Found - 6" Vine Maple (1882) alive & in fair condition considering
the number of inscribed cruises marks. Scribe on bark
mostly visible.

48" Fir S. 50° E. 12 lks. 7.9 ft., Bearing should read N. 50° E.
(Now 50" Fir, scribing visible on bark.)
5" Vine Maple S. 50° W. 19.8 ft., gone.
6" Vine Maple N. 10° W. 16.5 ft., found rotted on ground.
30" Fir N. 65° E. 21.8 ft., bearing should read S. 65° E.
(Now Stump, found some scribing.)

New BT's: 48" Fir S. 88° E. 37.2 ft, "W" Nail & Plate.
50" Fir N. 48° E. 8.0 ft. " " " (Orig. BT)
54" Fir N. 66° W. 25.9 ft. " " "
17" Hemlock S. 34° W. 32.7 ft. " " "
