1/4 Corner to Sections 23 and 24.  
Found - Haines' "T" Iron at Corner (not recorded).  
Orig. 48", now 50" Fir Stump N. 60° E. 14.5 ft., no scar,  
no scribe found.  
Orig. 18", now 36" Fir S. 87° W. 46.2 ft. (face) 1/4" Bark  
scribe very old in poor condition, "363 1/4 S23 BT".  
(Rescribe above old scribe-BT alive & in good condition)  
8" Hemlock N. 37° E. 4.8 ft. unrecorded, mkd: 1/4 S24 BT &  
Haines' button on face, leaning badly.  
New BT's: 6" Yew N. 21° W. 34.6 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S23 CS BT.  
10" Hemlock N. 52° E. 14.7 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S24 CS BT.

1/4 Corner to Sections 20 and 21.  
Found - Haines' "T" Iron, see Ren. #26-A.  
42" D. Fir S. 62° W. 60.0 ft., bark scribed.  
Orig. 18", now 29" Fir Stump S. 25° E. 16.5 ft., bark scribed,  
"CS BT", we chop open & find "BT" scribe.  
No trace other Orig. BT.  
New BT'S: 5" D. Fir S. 18° W. 3.6 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S20 CS BT.  
7" D. Fir S. 77° E. 19.0 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S21 CS BT.  
This corner lies approximately 10.0 ft. S. of small creek, course N. E.

1/4 Corner to Sections 5 and 4. *FD OK Les Roberts 7/96 M125-48*  
Found - Thiel's Bearing Trees, as recorded Ren. #18.  
Orig. 10", now 40" Redwood (Cedar) N. 76° E. 8.6 ft., now stump,  
burned out, no scribe.  
20", now 22" Fir N. 82° W. 29.7 ft. "4" scribe visible on  
burned face, now Snag. *211*  
22", now 24" Fir Stump N. 45° E. 13.9 ft. "CS 1/4" scribe visible  
on upper face, prev. opened.  
Haines' "T" Iron bears N. 64° W. 11.7 ft.  
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1965 *FD. 1984 W. HAINES M 70-56*  
T23S R4W 1/4 S 5/S 4  
New BT's: 18" D. Fir S. 8° W. 32.8 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S 5 CS BT.  
*(C. S. Tracy)* → 11" R. Cedar N. 52° E. 58.5 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S 4 CS BT.  
Corner lies on W. edge of old cat road, course N.E. & S.W.

1/4 Corner to Sections 22 and 23. *H-337*  
Found - Haines' "T" Iron, not recorded. *(SEE F.B. H-223 for IR & BT.) 9/20/85*  
Orig. 10", now 24", Fir N. 20° E. 29.7 ft., shows "1/4" scribe  
on previously opened face.  
S.W. BT. now only rotted remains.  
New BT's: 9" W. Fir S. 64° W. 20.2 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S22 CS BT.  
16" D. Fir N. 40° E. 52.6 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S23 CS BT.  
This corner lies on top, small spur, course S. W.

Sec. Cor. to Secs. 12 & 13, T23-4W. & Secs. 7 & 18, T23-3W.  
Found - Orig. 80", now 86" Fir N. 61° E. 12.5 ft., recorded N. 50° E.,  
*FD OK 2/93 Hoffine C.S. 63/149* shows "S R W" bark scribe & "W" Nail at base. Alive.  
Orig. 12", now 38" Cedar S. 55° E. 7.9 ft., several cruiser's  
marks & "W" Nail. Did not open. Alive.  
Orig. 15", now 26" Cedar, N. 50° W. 29.7 ft., burned out Snag,  
No scribe found.  
52" Fir Stump N. 5° E. 51.8 ft. *(See Ren. #100)* "W" Nail & Tag.  
12" Cedar S. 51° W. 32.0 ft., "W" Nail & Tag, not scribed. Alive.  
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: Doug. Co. Surv. T 23 S S 12 | S 7  
Office, 1965 R 4 W S 13 | S 18 R3W  
New BT: 9" Hemlock N. 24° W. 70.4 ft. Mkd: T23S R4W S12 DCS BT.

Sec. Cor. to Secs. 13 & 24, T23-4W. & Secs. 18 & 19, T23-3W.  
Found - Orig. 6", now 8" Vine Maple Corner Tree, bark scribe on S.W. Side,  
other scribe fragmentary.  
Orig. BT's., now stumps with only S.E. in position.  
Orig. 30", now 44" Fir Stump S. 65° E. 21.8 ft., shows "S" bark sch.
