

Douglas County Surveyor's Record of
Government Corners Renewed

T. 23 S. T. S. R. 4 W. R. W. W. M.

161

1/4 corner for sections 6 and 7.

Found - A 2"x1/2"x12" iron bar protruding 6" and a 3 1/2"x3/8"x18" iron bar protruding 9", from a rough mound of stone located in an old east-west fence line. Ren. #28

Badly rotted remains of fir stump bears N.47°W., 13.9 ft., originally a 30" fir. No remains of other orig. bearing tree.

36" fir, is now a 40" downed tree, no scribe marks visible, bears S.43°E., 52.8 ft. Ren. #11

40" fir, is now a fir stump 50" diam. at base, 26" DBH, 5 ft. tall, BT scribe visible in otherwise decayed, bears N.59°E., 33.0 ft.

A tree, now a 20" fir stump 16" tall, no scribe marks visible but possible blaze scar, bears N.66°E., 25.8 ft. (record, N.63°E., 40 lks.) Ren. #17

18" now 23" R. Fir with well healed double blaze, bears S.35°E., 29.8 ft. Ren. #28

11" now 14" D. Fir with partially healed double blaze scribe marks visible, bears N.35°E., 26.6 ft. Ren. #151

Set - Accepting position of iron bars as supported by evidence found, We Set 36" x 1" I.P. with brass cap attached marked: "Douglas County Surveyor" T23S S6 S7 R4W 1979. Cap is set in mound of stone 30" x 22" x 12" high. Iron bars set alongside cap.

New BT's- 9" D. Fir marked T23S R4W S7 CS BT" on double blaze, bears S21°W., 41.9 ft.

14" D. Fir marked T23S R4W S6 CS BT" on double blaze, bears N.19 1/2°W., 42.6 ft.

1/4 Corner for Sections 7 and 8.

Found - Haines "T" iron capped with bronze washer reading "Wilford N. Haines, Survey Point, 239, Drain Oregon" protruding 12" from ground and firmly set. Ren. #46

Orig. 4" x 36" post and marked stone searched for AND NOT FOUND.

Orig. 30" Pine, now stump 6 ft. tall 34" DBH with old bark scribing 4 ft. high on NW side reading "1/4 S", a Haines washer on NW side of stump bears S.36°E., 11.0 ft. from Haines T iron. Ren. #46

Orig. 36" fir, now stump 7 ft. tall 38" DBH with old bark scribing from 2 to 4 ft. high on NE side scribed "1/4 S BT", A Haines washer on NE side bears S.11°W., 27.7 ft. slope distance from Haines T iron. (Rec. bearing S.14°W., and we assume dist. 27.7 ft. should be a horizontal dist.)

8" Fir now stump 4 ft. tall 9" DBH with well healed double blaze no scribing visible, bears N.61°E., 16.5 ft. from Haines T iron. (Rec. N.59°E., 16.9 ft. Ren. #116

8" Fir now stump 4 ft. long 8" diam., down and burned, evidence of burned out blaze, bears S.26°W., 43.7 ft. Ren. #116

Set - Because of face measurement ~~of~~ orig. Pine and face and slope dist. and bad bearing to orig. fir, We Set new monument by measuring orig. bearings and horizontal distances from root crown center or orig. bearing trees. We Set: 1" x 36" I.P. with brass cap attached marked: Douglas County Surveyor T23S R4W 1/4 S7 S8 1979.

New Accessories:

Original bearing trees as described above are now at record bearing and distance from brass cap.

8" NE tree is now N.57°E., 16.1 ft.

8" SW bearing tree is now S.28°W., 43.0 ft.

Haines "T" iron is N.43 1/2°W., 1.2 ft.

New bearing object, a boat spike stamped B0 and driven in a 26" Fir stump bears S.83°W., 33.7 ft. from brass cap.

South 1/4 Corner for Sec. 7.

Found - 1" x 36" I.P. with 1959 County Surveyors Brass cap properly stamped, protruding 12" above ground, located in an E-W fence.

An orig. 40" Fir now a 60" stump bears N.35°W., 81.2 ft.

(79.2 ft. face meas.) No visible bark scribe as found in Ren. #35.

An orig. 6" fir, now 41" with no visible scar, a large "x" on back side, bears S.66°W., 10.6 ft.

An 11" fir, now a 17" with well healed double blaze bears North 25.7 ft. (Ren. #35)

A 13" Fir now a 23" with well healed double blaze bears S.28 1/2°E. 26.8 ft.

New BT - A 21" Fir with scribe "1/4 S7 CS BT" in a double blaze bears N.11 1/2°W., 138.6 ft.
