T. 23 S. T. S. R. 7 W. R. W. W. M.

ROKE-CHAPMAN CO., EUGENE, ORE. 21881

North 1/4 Corner to Section 6 only. 100

Found - W. Oak, now 27", S. 7°W, 79.2 ft., chopped open & found good scribing "S". Ren.#27A

W.Oak, now 30", S.20°E. 130.0 ft., shows scar.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1962

New BT's: 20" W.Oak S. 4°W. 62.5 ft. Mkd: 1/2 S31 CS BT. #171  
22" D.Fir S. 53°E. 69.8 ft. Mkd: 1/2 S6 CS BT.

Corner is in Fence Corner - Fences E. - W. - & S. from corner.

North Boundary T23S-7W - C.losing Corner. S31/S32 T22S R7W. 101

Found - Sandstone Rock 4" x 10", 10" above surface of ground, Mkd: "SC" on S. face, (see renewal No. 46) #178

Oak Stump, uprooted & south side rotted away N. 1/4 BT, 248.5 ft.

No trace of renewal BT. to N.W. found, Orig. BT S. gone at time

DO NOT SET BRASS CAP of old renewal.

New BT's: 19" D.Fir N. 36°W. 92.6 ft. Mkd: T22S R7W S31 CS BT.

29" W.Oak N. 15°E. 234.0 ft. Mkd: T22S R7W S32 CS BT.

Corner lies in Fence Corner - Fences West & North.

N. Boundary T23-7W. - South 1/4 Corner to Section 31 only, T22-7W. 102

Found - W.Oak, now 28", N. 48 1/2°E. 64.7 ft. Cut scar open & found good scribing "SC" - approx. 50 years old. (renewal No. 46) A-T22-7W.

Oak Stump N. 68°W. 119.5 ft., shows good scar.

Set - Brass Cap at Corner Mkd: County Surveyor's T22S R7W 1/4 S31 only Office, 1962 T23S R7W

New BT's: 7" D.Fir N. 33°W. 8.7 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S31 CS BT.

12" D.Fir N. 31°E. 9.3 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S31 CS BT.

Corner lies in East & West Fence Line.

North 1/4 Corner to Section 24. 103

Found Nothing - Set 2" angle Iron, 36" Long, from which a:

14" Yew bears S. 50 1/2°W. 71.5 ft., scribed "1/2 S BT".

14" W.Fir " N. 65°E. 21.6 ft., scribed "1/2 S BT".

Center 1/4 Corner to Section 24. 104

Set - 1" x 30" Aluminum Pipe from which a:

14" D.Fir bears N. 29 1/2°E. 27.0 ft. scribed "C 1/4 BT".

26" D.Fir bears S. 63 1/2°W. 10.7 ft., scribed "C 1/4 BT".

South 1/4 Corner to Section 24. 105

Found - Original Bearing Trees.

Set - Square Wood Stake from which a:

52" Balf bears N. 46°W. 9.2 ft., bark scribes visible.

52" D.Fir bears S. 15°E. 26.4 ft., scribes no longer visible.

Old cruiser marks on nearby trees.

(SEE REN.#142)

North 1/4 Corner to Section 4 only. 106

Set - "T" Iron & Cap.

12" D.Fir S. 57°W. 21.1 ft., blazed & scribed, not legible, completely pitched over, Haines' metal disc on tree.

An old Oak Stump, uprooted, showing an upper & lower scar,

both of which are completely rotted out inside bears S. 87°E.

641.8 ft. Gov't. notes call for a 20" W.Oak S. 87°E. 607.2 ft.

No trace of old S.W. BT. found.
