Found - Oregon St. Board of Forestry 1½" x 36" galv.  
IP/3" bronze cap, 1970 (ren #81)  
12" Hemlock (1906) S.85°W., 38 lks., now 35" x 5'  
high stump in place, faced closed. Yellow  
metal location poster.  
25" Hemlock (1970) N.63°W., 67.1 ft., now 28"x5'  
high rotten stump, scribes visible.  
White painted cedar post (1970) N.30°W., 2.0 ft.  
(now rotted & fallen over)  
New BOs - 7" Alder S.34°W., 24.1 ft. to aluminum nail in BT  
face, bark scribed: CCT23SR10WS22BT. Bearing  
tree tag.  
10" Hemlock N.56°W., 76.3 ft. to aluminum nail in  
BT face scribed: T23SR10WS15CCBT.  
Orange Carsonite markers CBM-25OR labeled WP bears:  
S.74½°W., 2.75 ft. to base.  
N.5°W., 2.50 ft. to base.  
Closing corner 0.55 ft. East of true line.

IP/3" bronze cap, 1959 (ren #45)  
12" Fir (1906) S.77°E., 23 lks., now windfall  
downhill, face exposed & badly decayed, no  
scribes visible.  
10" Fir (1906) N.80°W., 44 lks., now 23"x 5' high  
rotten stub in place exposed, no scribes  
visible.  
Summit of divided South 37 lks.  
30" Fir (1959) S.60°E., 36.9 ft., now 45" x 2' high  
stump face closed.  
20" Fir (1959) N.57½°E., 50.1 ft, now 28" face closed.  
16" Fir (1959) S.88°W., 40.2 ft., yellow metal  
location poster only, now 16"x3' high rotten  
stub, yellow metal location poster fallen off.  
White painted cedar post NW 1.5 ft. now rotten and  
fallen over.

scribed: S14BT. Bearing tree tag.
