scribing visible "T24S RLW S27 BT."  
18" Fir N.47°W. 53.5 ft., shows good scar.  
22" Pine S.60°E. 9.2 ft., shows good scars.  
12" Fir N.65°E. 4.3 ft, instead of 42.9 ft., shows good scars.

All old BT's. in good condition except Pine in S.W. Quad.

Section Corner to Sections 15 - 14 - 22 - 23. 19  
Found - Dead Pine, now 40", S.35°W. 10.6 ft., previously opened,  
good scribing visible.  
22" Fir N.19°E. 29.7 ft., shows 2 good scars. Did not open.  
34" Fir S.56½°E. 29.0 ft., shows good scar. Did not open.  
36" Fir N.48°W. 21.8 ft., shows good scar. Did not open.  
Did not find rock at corner as called for. Note-Pine is  
S.35°W. instd of N.35°W. as called for in Gov't notes.)

Found - 18" Fir S.17½°E. 14.5 ft., scribing visible "¼ SBT",  
blaze had never grown over.  
10" Fir Snag N.82°W. 7.9 ft.. scribing visible "¼ SBT",  
(notes say S.82°W.) blaze had never grown over.  
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1962  
T24S RLW ¼ S17/S16  
New BT's: 10" Hemlock N.73½°W. 7.6 ft. mkd: ¼ S17 CS BT.  
17" D. Fir S.67°E. 26.1 ft. mkd: ¼ S16 CS BT.

¼ Corner to Sections 7 and 18. 21  
Found - Rock set by Nicklin in 1896. Rock Mkd: "¼" on N. Face.  
D.Fir, now 30", S.33°W. 4.6 ft. Very plain axe scar.  
Reblaze & Scribe this tree "¼ S18 CS BT".  
D.Fir, now 17", N.65°E. 7.9 ft. good axe scars visible.  
Reblaze & Scribe this tree "¼ S7 CS BT".  
Along N. Side of Rock at Corner Set Brass Cap for Corner Mkd:  
County Surveyor's Office, 1962 T24S RLW ¼

Found - Madrone, now 12", N.50°E. 10.6 ft. Chopped open &  
found good scribing "S".  
22" D.Fir, not a Madrone, S.22°W. 27.1 ft., shows 2 very  
plain old scars. Reblaze & scribe this tree "¼ S20 CS BT".  
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's

New BT: 6" D.Fir N.8½°E. 15.6 ft. Mkd: ¼ S17 CS BT.

¼ Corner to Sections 28 and 33. 23  
Found - Rock called for by Nicklin Mkd: "¼" on N. face.  
D. Fir, now 20", N.41°W. 11.7 ft. not 11.2 ft. Old  
scar very plain. Reblaze & scribe this tree "¼ S28CS BT".  
D. Fir, now 21", S.8°W. 16.8 ft., not 17.8 ft., Old scar very  
plain. Reblaze & scribe this tree "¼ S33 CS BT."  
Alongside Rock at Cor. Set Brass Cap Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1962.
