 Found - Brass cap on I.P. from Ren. 64 NOT found. Area around corner is in power line r/w & property owner, Clifford Bryden, indicated area had been bulldozed 4-5 yrs. ago. 10" now 32" dia. B. Oak w/previously opened now healed single blaze & BT tag bears, S.78½°E., 378.2 ft. (Orig. BT) No remaining BT's or any evidence of their location found of BT's from Ren. #64.
 West power pole from Ren.#64 appears to have been replaced. High peak of house bears N.75½°W. (Rec. N.75°W.) Ren.#64.
 Set - DCSO 2 3/8" dia. brass cap on 1½" outside dia. x 31" long I.P. set at Record bearing & distance from remaining Orig. BT (N.78½°W., 378.2 ft.). Protrudes 5" above ground.

 16" dia. Apple double blazed & scribed "X BT" bears S.29°W., 122.7 ft.
 8" dia. W. Oak double blazed & scribed "T24SR4WS7 CS BT" bears S.82½°W., 174.2 ft.

 Corner lies in power line r/w, a metal fence post is set 1 ft. West.

 Found - A 2½" dia. Brass cap on a 1½" O.D. Iron pipe protruding 1 ft. above ground. Ren. #122
 5" now 17" dia. W.Oak with fully healed blaze, bears N.82°E., 69.9 ft. (agrees w/record)
 6" now 15" dia. W.Oak with a fully healed blaze bears S.78°W., 38.2 ft. (agrees w/rec.)
 Original BTs gone.
 New accessories:
 6" dia. Oak double blazed and scribed "X BT" bears N.42½°E., 57.1 ft.
 Power pole "3H4-22 1 30 10429" bears s.40°E., 54.0ft.
 Corner lies 1 ft. southeasterly of a fence line.

 24" now 24" dia. D. Fir with a fully healed single blaze, bears S.28°E., 42.2 ft., (Rec. S.26½°E. 42.2 ft.) 1985 BLM.
 8" now 8" dia. dead 20 ft. high D. Fir snag, with a partially healed single blaze, scribing visible "N 1/16 S34 BT" bears S.83½°W., 84.5 ft. (agrees with record) 1985 BLM.
 Set - 36" dia., 4 ft. high D. Fir stump with boat spike set through BT tag on top B.S. bears N.14°E., 104.8 ft. (boat spike is 8" long and stamped BO2 on top).
 New Accessories -
 3" dia., D. Fir double blazed and scribed "x BT" bears N.43½°W., 42.9 ft.
 23" dia., 5 ft. high D. Fir stump with boat spike set through BT tag on top (has a chopped out blaze on southwest trunk) B.S. bears S.74½°E., 19.6 ft. (Boat spike is 8" long and stamped BO1 on top).
