Found - BLM Brass Cap & one live BT., other BT, down & out of position.
25", now 26" Fir S.44³/₄°E. 82.2 ft., face grown over. Do not open.
27", now 29" Fir N.74°W. 54.8 ft., lying face up, dead.
New BT: 11" D.Fir N.18°E. 100.8 ft. mkd: E 1/16 S18 CS BT.

N. 1/16 Sections 18 and 17.
Found - BLM Brass Cap, 1957, & BT's. as follows:
7", now 11" Fir S.71¹/₄°E. 41.3 ft., scar healed over,
We do not open.
17", now 18" Fir Snag N.13¹/₄°W. 30.4 ft., scribe visible on
partially healed over blaze. Snag is about 20 ft. high.
New BT: 9" Madrone N.23°W. 46.7 ft. Mkd: N 1/16 S18 CS BT.
Note - This corner lies in N. - S. fence.

C, S. 1/16 Section 13.
Found - BLM Brass Cap as mkd. in 1958.
13" D.Fir N.31¹/₂°E. 28.7 ft., now snag, shows scribe on
pitched over face.
12", now 21" Cedar S.35°W. 99.3 ft., top broken off
approximately 20 ft. above ground, still alive.
New BT: 14" I. Cedar N.89°W. 137.7 ft. Mkd: CS 1/16 S13 CS BT.
Note - This corner lies 3.5 ft. East of N. - S. Fence.

N. 1/16 Sections 27 and 28.
Found - 10", now 12" D.Fir S.68°W. 19.1 ft., recorded as W. Fir.
Partially grown over scar, we find scribing.
BLM Brass Cap & other BT destroyed by slide in small creek.
The BT. found does not appear to have been affected by slide.
Because of the possibility of continued sliding in the
immediate area, we set Witness Corner 32.0 ft. South.

Found - BLM Brass Cap set in 1957 & both BT's. now snags.
9" Fir, now 11", N.2¹/₂°W. 37.6 ft., shows faint scribe on
burned face.
15", now 15" Cedar S.6°W. 17.8 ft., face badly burned,
no scribe visible. Rescribe Cedar W1/16 S27 CS BT."
New BT's: 12" Madrone N. 1° W. 90.5 ft. Mkd: W 1/16 S22 CS BT.
12" Madrone S.87°E. 97.3 ft. Mkd: W 1/16 S 27 CS BT.

E. 1/16 Sections 29 and 32.
Found - BLM Brass Cap, 1957 & one live BT.
7", now 10" Fir S.30³/₄°E. 40.3 ft., blaze healed over. Didn't open.
18" Fir N.54°E. 26.7 ft., laying face up.
New BT: 5" D.Fir N.22°E. 19.7 ft. Mkd: E 1/16 S29 CS BT.

W. 1/16 Sections 8 and 17. S 8
Found - BLM Brass Cap Mkd: W 1/16 S17 1957 & one live BT.
8", now 10" Laurel N.59¹/₂°E. 25.7 ft., shows scribe on partially
healed scar.
18", now 22" Fir S.40¹/₂°W. 75.2 ft., now stump, scribe marks
visible on partially healed scar.
New BT: 5" W.Oak S.26°W. 62.4 ft. Mkd: W 1/16 S17 CS BT.
Note - This corner lies on top small spur between two small creeks.
