Found - 28" White Oak N.80°E. 56.1 ft. Tree opened many years ago, some scribing visible on partially rotted old face.

New BT's: 10" W. Oak S.41°E. 43.0 ft. Mkd: NW DLC 58 CS BT.
27" W. Oak S.18°E. 64.0 ft. Mkd: NW DLC 58 CS BT.
Note - Corner falls in old fence corner, fences S.12°E., N.78°E., and approximately N. W. from corner.

Found - Old Cedar Stake lying on ground at Corner. See Ren. #22.
16" W.Oak S.34½°W.13.0 ft., shows very good scars, didn't open.
Dead Black Oak Stub 10 to 12 ft. high, N.75°W. 16.5 ft., Center rotted away, Orig. BT.
No trace of Orig. S. E. Bearing Tree.
Brass Cap for Sec. Cor. to Secs. 2 - 1 - 11 - 12 bears S. 37.6 ft.
Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964
T25S R5W N.W. DLC 43
New BT: 11" D.Fir N.24½°E. 21.3 ft. Mkd: NW. DLC 43 CS BT.
Note - Fence Corner, fences North & East, bears S.31°W. 30.0 feet.
