Set corner from one O. B. T., a 15" Oak N 51° W  
175 lks. Tree is down but found B. T. mark.  
Set an axle 1 1/2"x54" 6" disk at top and a 3"x3"x36"  
Oak stake from which:  
A 16" Fir S 37 1/4° W 40.3 ft.  
A 14" Fir N 65 3/4° W 85.1 ft.  
No tree NE.  
A 20" Fir S 39 1/4° E 49.1 ft.

1/4 Cor 26-35 42  
Found two O. B. T., one in good shape the other down  
and rotting.  
Set 1 1/2"x18" I. rod from which:  
A 18" Fir bears N 77 1/2° E 8.3 ft.  
A 8" Fir bears S 19 1/2° W 23.1 ft.

Sec. Cor. N. side 5-6 43  
Location identified by two O. B. T., original scribe marks  
still legible but trees down and rotting.  
Oak bearing S 74° W 136 lks.  
Fir bearing N 13° W 58 lks.  
Marked new B. T.'s. - Set a 4" x 4" x 48" Cedar post 15' in the  
ground for the corner.  
14" Fir bearing N 75° E 28.0 ft. dist.  
18" Fir bearing N 1° W 60.0 ft. dist.  
22" Fir bearing S 4° W 64.6 ft. dist.  
16" Fir bearing S 37° E 68.0 ft. dist.

1/4 Cor. W. Bdy of Sec. 5 44  
Set ~~Set~~ S. Stone for 1/4 cor on W. bdy of Sec. 5  
R. Fir, 14" diam. bears N 46° 40' W 77 lks. dist., Old B. T. evidence  
E. fir 34" diam. bears N 47° 30' E 39 lks. dist.

1/4 Cor. between 6 & 5 45  
Bearing trees standing & in good shape  
Set 1 1/4" iron rod from bearing trees.

Northwest corner of the Joseph N. Smith Donation Land Claim No. 57. 48  
Large Rock at corner - We marked  
10 inch Forked Black Oak, N. 82°45'W., 70.8 feet.  
14 inch Black Oak, N. 56°30'E., 47.0 feet. Both trees on edge  
of small creek.

Northwest corner of the Joseph N. Smith Donation Land Claim No. 57. 49  
This corner found by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor  
on Sept. 12, 1955 with corner stone in place.  
Bearing trees found (with scribing) at proper bearing and distance from corner  
but NW tree is a 24" W. O. and the NE tree is a 12" Ash instead of being as  
noted by Mr. Frear on March 10, 1955.
