Found - 1916 G.L.O. Brass Cap, firmly set & properly marked.
✓ Orig. 36", now 48" Fir, alive, N. 50° E. 26.4 ft., shows good scar.
Rescribed "T26S R2W S24 CS BT" in bark.
Orig. 8", now 11" Chamaequin Snag, N. 20° W. 13.9 ft., shows "6S 23"
scribe on open blaze.
Orig. S. W. BT. gone & Orig. S.E. BT.; burned stub.
New BT's: ✓ 18" Cedar S. 5° E. 91.4 ft. mkd. T26S R2W S25 CS BT.
✓ 10" Pine Snag, N. 56° W. 7.9 ft. mkd. T26S R2W S23 CS BT.
No trees nor stumps to southwest.
Note - Corner lies on east edge of old logging road near landing.
Sections 23, 24 & 26 logged off many years ago.

Orig. 6", now 12" Cedar, alive, N. 47° E. 11.9 ft., shows scar.
Rescribe: "T26S R2W S21 CS BT."
Orig. 6", now 11" Maple, alive, S. 43° E. 13.2 ft., shows scar.
Rescribe: "T26S R2W S28 CS BT"/
Orig. 16", now 24" Hemlock, alive, S. 32° W. 10.6 ft., scribe marks vis.
on open blaze. No trace of N.W. BT.

We chain south from closing corner of secs. 20 & 21,
414.0 ft. to exact point for ¼ corner as determined by Orig. BT's:
Orig. 12" Cedar, now 16" sawed stump under logs one of which is
other Orig. BT., N. 72° E. 14.5 ft., shows frag. scribe
marks on decayed blaze.
Orig. 24" Fir, now 30", down & out of position, S. 86° W. 9.9 ft.,
Open blaze & find "¼" S20" under 45+ years of overgrowth.
Mensch's record distance betwn. C.C. & ¼ Corner is 417.8 ft.
