New BT's: (See Corner over) #94

12" W.Oak N.87°W. 226.0 ft. Mkd: T26S R5W S18 CS BT.  
14" W.Oak S.80°W. 316.2 ft. Mkd: T26S R5W S19 CS BT.  
8" W.Oak N.17½°E. 448.7 ft. Mkd: T26S R5W S17 CS BT.  
No trees near to S. E.

Note - Fence corner, fences North, West, & S. E., bears S.5°E. 6.0 ft.

¼ Corner to Sections 17 and 20. 95

Found - 38" Bl. Oak S.78°E. 386.1 ft. Opened & found good reverse scribing "BT". Tree in poor condition.

Stump Hole & Remnants of Oak Tree N.79°W. 533.3 ft.

Remnants show burl wood & portion of overgrowth of old face.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964 T26S R5W ¼ S17 S20

New BT's: 10" White Oak N.55°E. 96.7 ft. Mkd: ¼ S17 CS BT.  
7" Black Oak S.75°E. 137.4 ft. Mkd: ¼ S20 CS BT.

¼ Corner to Sections 9 and 10. 96

Found - 16" Bl. Oak S.10°W. 185.5 ft. Cut open & fd. good scribng, "S".  
30" Bl. Oak S.14°E. 145.2 ft., shows 2 very plain scars. Did not open.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964 T26S R5W ¼ S 9/S 10

New BT's: 12" Bl. Oak N.41°W. 28.3 ft. Mkd: ¼ S9 CS BT.

19" White Oak N.58°E. 12.2 ft. Mkd: ¼ S10 CS BT.

Note - Corner is in draw, approximately 150 ft. N. of small winter creek.

Sec. Cor. to Secs. 1 & 12, T26-5W. & Secs. 6 & 7, T26-4W. 97

Found - 36" Bl. Oak S.63°E. 272.9 ft., chopped open & fd. good scribng. No trace of other Bearing Trees.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964 T26S R5W S 1 S 6 R4W S 12 S 7 #159

New BT's: 18" W.Oak S.50°E. 322.8 ft. Mkd: T26S R4W S7 CS BT.

20" D.Fir N.81½°E. 320.0 ft. Mkd: T26S R4W S6 CS BT.

Note - No trees near west of line. Corner lies 4 ft. south of E. & W. fence line, and just east of top of bald, grassy ridge.

¼ Corner common to Sections 35 and 36. 98

Found - 20" Bl. Oak S.54°E. 41.6 ft., opened & found good scribing visible, "BT", tree now dead, but standing.

16" W.Oak S.72°W. 39.6 ft., opened & found good scribing, "BT". Tree nearly dead.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964 T26S R 5W. ¼ S35/S36

New BT's: 17" D.Fir N.28½°E. 54.6 ft. Mkd: ¼ S36 CS BT.

17" I.Cedar S. 5°W. 147.2 ft. Mkd: ¼ S35 CS BT.

Note - Bearings given not true bearings, read with staff compass set on variation of 19° 30' E.

Found 1" Iron Pipe 1.4 ft. north of brass cap.

Fence Corner, fences outh & west bears N.85°W. 4.0 ft.

S. W. Corner D. L. C. No. 48. 99

Found - Rock called for in previous renewal, Ren. No. 3. #158  
38" W.Oak N.66½°E. 58.1 ft., shows good scar, Did not open.

No trace of other tree called for in Original Notes.

Set - Brass Cap alongside Roak & Mkd: County Surveyor's Office, 1964 T26S R5W S.W. Cor. DLC 48

Blaze & Rescribe 38" W.Oak N.66½°E. 58.1 ft. Mkd: SW DLC 48 CS BT.

New BT's: 15" W.Oak S.31°E. 67.6 ft. Mkd: S W DLC 48 CS BT.

Note - Corner is in N. & S. fence line 65 ft. N. or 3-way fence corner, fences North, South & East.
