old face with legible scribing "C50 T 26 S"

At corner, stake made from old pine knot. (approx. 4" square &  
18" long)

Office 1964 T 26 SR 6 W SW DLC 50 "

New BTS: 18" black oak S  $35^{\circ}$  W 25. 8 ft. Mkd: SW DLC 50 CS BT.

16" black oak N  $38^{\circ}$  E 11.9 ft. Mkd: SW DLC 50 CS BT.

A fence corner (fences North & West) bears N  $10^{\circ}$  W 11.0 ft.

face down.
