$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner to Sections 20 & 21.

Found - $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pipe in mound of rocks. No record of iron pipe in corner renewal book, but is shown on Cole's Map of Survey M 1-69. (Ren. # 6)
Old stump hole with fragments of oak lying around it. S $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 186 ft. fits original SE BT.
Possible stump hole S $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 23 ft. fits Cole's new BT.
Location also checks calls in Government Field Notes to draw North of corner.
Did not set Brass Cap.

7" Madrone N. 20° E. 288.0 ft. Mkd: " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 CS BT"

Shows old axe scars.
Badly Burned & rotted Fir stump S. 14° E 211.0 ft. No mks Fd.
Badly burned Fir snag S 41° W. 275.4 ft. No mks. fd.
New BTS: 14" Madrone S. 76° W. 69.4 ft. Mkd: "T26 SR 6 W S18 CS BT"
12" Madrone N. 60° W 80.5 ft. Mkd: "T26 SR 6 W S7 CS BT"
13" Madrone S $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 140.5 ft. Mkd: "T26 SR 6 W S17 CS BT"

Found - Gun Barrel set by Irving in 1926. (See Ren. # 32)
24" B. Oak N. 60° E. 57.4 ft. Good scribing " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 CS" visible on open blaze. Tree in poor condition;
B. Oak (now 40" diam) N. 69° W. 56.0 ft. Shows very good axe scars.

Found - Incense Cedar (now 30" Diam) S 66° W. 54.0 ft. Shows very plain axe scars. Tree alive & in good condition. (Ren # 30)
Hollow stub of Black Oak N. 22° E 72.0 ft. Fd. good reverse scribing.
Iron Pipe out of ground.

Reset iron pipe alongside.

Found - Gun Barrel Set by Irving in 1926. (Ren # 34)
Badly rotted Fir stump N. 28° W 55.5 ft. Found good scribing on old face "CS BT"
No trace fd. fo SE tree mkd. by Irving.
Set - Alongside gun barrel Brass Cap mkd: "County Surveyor's Office 1964 T 26 SR 6 W $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8
