N.W. Cor. of the Thomas Stephens D.L.C. #40

$\frac{3}{4}$ " I.P. flush with pavement from which
N.E. Cor. of the Catholic Cemetery bears S. 4° W. 31.2 Ft.
A $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 30" I.P. at the S.W. Cor. of Percy Webb property
bears N. 78° 40' E. 182.3 Ft.

RE-NEWED; SEE CORNER NO. #146

N.W. CORNER OF D.L.C. # 41

Renewed from old B.T. by setting a 10" x 10" x 18" Rock
and a 3" x 36" Oak Stake. I remarked the old B.T. viz. a 18"
White Oak S. 25° E., 282 lks. I also marked
Black Oak 5" dia. bears S. 64° W., 42 lks. scribed C.S.
C. 41 B.T.

SECTION CORNER BETWEEN 17 and 18.

Set a 3" x 3" x 36" Oak Stake established corner from old
B.T. scribe marks still visible and stump of old B.T. Marked
new B.T.s as follows

Black Oak 7" dia. bears N. 38° W., 108 lks.
Black Oak 4" dia. bears S. 70° E., 111 lks.
Pine on ridge 24" dia. bears S. 56° W., 225 lks. not
scribed

SECTION CORNER BETWEEN 23 and 24.

A Pitch pine post 6" square 6" above ground mark $\frac{1}{4}$.
Marked new trees.

Black Oak 12" dia. bears N. 78° 27' W., 144 lks. blazed and
scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 23 C.S. B.T. Cl. 42
Black Oak 6" dia. bears S. 21° 38' E., 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. blazed and
scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 24 C.S. B.T.

This is also the interior angle corner of D.L.C. # 42
this post is in place and has been used as the corner for
many years.

S.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. # 49.

Set Iron pipe for corner from old White Oak B.T. Marked
A 14" White Oak S. 71° 30' E., 109 ft. for new witness
tree

N.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. # 37

Set Iron Pipe from old B.T. for corner. and marked a
12" White Oak S. 34° 30' W., 33 ft. for new bearing tree.

INTERIOR "L" CORNER OF CL. #45

Set from Ash tree marked by Briggs. Set Iron Shaft 124
1" x 18" from which I marked new bearing trees as follows
Ash 8" N. 15° 30' W., 25.3 ft. marked C.S. Cl. 45 B.T.
Apple 18" S. 85° 30' W., 46.0 ft. marked C.S. Cl. 45 B.T.
Apple 18" N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 38.0 ft. marked C.S. Cl. 45 B.T.

S.E. EXTERIOR "L" COR. OF CALIM, D.L.C. 39

Set $\frac{3}{4}$ " Iron Pipe 24" long for corner from which a 15"
Ash marked C. 39 C.S. bears S. 0° 22' E., 36.7 ft. (tack in
upper blaze) a $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 18" Iron Pipe bears N. 1° 04' W., 10 ft.
and a cross on top cone curb on W. side Overlook Ave. bears
N. 89° 40' W., 94.9 ft. This cross is on a line produced
S. 89° .7' W., 95.4 ft. from a point N. 1° 04' W., 10 ft. from
D.L.C. corner.
