SOUTH WEST CORNER OF C.L. # 59.

Set a 12" x 4 " x 4" rock for the corner, Marked C 59, C. S.

One old bearing tree in evidence. New corner is pipe 1" x 24" and stone 6" x 8" x 12" from which
A Cedar 14" dia. bears N.25°55'E., 10 lks. dist.
(Center of tree)
A Fir 28" dia. bears N.78°30'W., 11 lks. dist.
(Center of tree)

RE-NEWED, SEE CORNER NO. 95

SECTION CORNER FOR SECTIONS 23, 24, 25, and 26.

Set in corner from tow old original bearing tree stumps letters legible. New Corner is 2" x 36" Iron Pipe (gal.) from which
A White Oak 15" dia. bears N.00°10'E., 8.72 chs. Nail in the tree marks exact sec. line N.
A White Oak 16" dia. bears S.75°00'W., 4.355 chs.
A white Oak 8" dia. bears S.16°07'E., 3.88 chs.

S.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. # 53

A 2" x 36" Galv. Iron Pipe set in for corner. (One old tree in evidence). Marked the following trees

SECTION CORNER 20, 21, 28 and 29.

Renew from two original bearing trees standing and two stumps of original bearing trees. Set Iron Pipe for corner. Marked
White Oak 8" dia. bears N.45°E., 50 ft.
White Oak 24" dia. bears S.67°E., 78 ft. O.B.T.
White Oak 18" dia. bears N.30°W., 67.8 ft.
White Oak 18" dia. bears S.27°W., 134 links O.B.T.

¼ CORNER BETWEEN 28 and 29.

Renew from stumps of original bearing trees. Set Iron pipe for corner. Marked the following trees
Fir 8" dia. bears S.58°E., 64.7 ft.
Pine 6" dia. bears N.25°E., 9 ft.

Corner approximately 35° South of the road. On line of old fence E. and W. sighting W. from corner.
