- 1 CORNERS OF W. M. MORIN CL. # 48 AND SECTION 24
N.W. COR.
Renew corner with an oak stake marked C.S.C.48 from which original B.T. bears S.83 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 804 lks.
- 2 N.E. CORNER
Renew corner with an oak post marked C.S. C.48 from which original bearing tree
A White Oak 14" dia. bears S.85°W., 450 lks.
- 3 EXTERIOR L. CORNER (S.E) 46
Set post from which a White Oak 30" dia. bears N.65°W., 27 lks. no marks visible but M. A. Cozad deposes and says that Oscar Thiel chopped out blaze and found original marks see Field Book 13 page 47. Also marked
A Laurel bears N.74°W., 35 lks. SEE REN. #43 190
- 4 INTERIOR L. CORNER
Renew corner with Laurel post marked C.S. C.48 from which original tree
A White Oak 10" dia. bears S.27°30'W., 55 lks.
- 5 EXTERIOR L. CORNER 77
Renew corner set rock from which original witness tree
A Pine 24" dia. bears N.45°W., 104 lks.
- 6 S.W. CORNER
Renew corner set rock from which stump of original bearing tree bears N.10°E., 92 lks. marked a new bearing tree
An Ash 14" dia. which bears N10°E., 105 lks. #187
- 7 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 13 and 24.
Renew corner and set post from which
An Oak 15" dia. bears S.80°E., 578 lks.
An Oak 12" dia. bears N.87°E., 601 lks. 98
- 8 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 24 and 25.
Renew corner and set post from which original B.T. are as follows
Black Oak 12" dia. bears N.30°W., 38 lks.
Black Oak 24" dia. bears S.38°W., 66 lks. 159
- 9 CORNER TO SECTIONS 19, 30, 25 and 24. ¹²⁷¹ ¹²⁷⁸
Renew corner with Laurel post marked S.34° on N.W., S.25 and C.S. on S.W., S.30 on S.E., and S.19 on N.E. ¹¹³⁰
trees down and two standing.
- 10 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 and 30
Set rock from which original trees bear as follows 65
A White Oak 18" dia. bears N.38 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 63 lks.
A White Oak 8" dia. bears N.53 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 121 lks.
- 11 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 23 and 24.
Find two trees corresponding to original witness trees to-wit
A Black Oak 10" dia. bears N.25°E., 14 lks. 99
A Black Oak 6" dia. bears S.60°E., 19 lks. (Rec Sw)
- 12 Tree N.25°E is badly chopped, no marks visible on either. Mark trees S.60°E. 19 lks. and N.25°E., 64 lks. Set Iron Pin $\frac{1}{2}$ x 30".
