Sec. Corner for Secs. 12, & 13, and Secs. 7, & 18 in T.27-6. **194**

Found - I.P. w/B.C. bent over & out of position. Mon. was pushed over by recent bulldozer work.
BTs - Orig. 11", now 25" diam. B.Oak, dbl.blazed w/upper blaze opened & rotted out, bears S.63°W. (Rec. S.60-1/2°W.), 20.5-ft.
Orig. 13", now 24" diam. B.Oak, rescribed per Ren#104 w/well healed dbl.blaze, bears N.32°W. (Rec. N.35°W.), 29.7-ft.
20", now 21" diam. B.Oak w/well healed dbl.blaze bears S.63°W., 28.1-ft. Ren.#104.
20" B.Oak, now down & rotted, root hole bears S.55°E., 115.3-ft. Ren.#104.
20", now 25" diam. B.Oak, w/well healed dbl.blaze bears N.58°E., (Rec. N.62°E., is to root crown of an oak and madrone trees that have grown together; north branch is the oak BT, south branch is a madrone tree) 16.3-ft. Ren#104.
Set - I.P. & B.C. per Ren.#104 was reset using distances of orig. BTs. Cap was stamped: "RESET 1984".
* Note---Orig. bearings when intersected did not fit the distances.
New BT - 17" B.Oak,dbl.blazed & scribed:"T27S R6W S18 CS BT", bears S.44°E.,130.2-ft.

W.C. to the N 1/4 Section Corner of Sec. 15. **195**

Found - 1-1/2" I.P. w/2-1/2" B.C. set by Doug.Co.Surveyor in 1960.
BTs - 26" W.Oak bears N.22°45'E.,10.2-ft. (N.20°E.,10-ft) good scar.
33" W.Oak (previously not of record), bears Ren.#82
S.25°15'E.,111.5-ft. Open face, no visible scribe. 5/84

W.C. to the Center 1/4 Sec. Corner of Sec. 15. **196**

Set - 1-1/2" x 30" I.P. w/2-1/2" B.C. mkd: "W C C1/4 T 27 S R 7 W S15 N 40 FT RLS 1654 1984."
New BTs - 14" D.Fir bears S.62°W.,32.4-ft. scribed: C 1/4 BT.
16" D.Fir bears S.63°E.,15.5-ft. scribed: C 1/4 BT. 5/84

W.C. to the Sec. Cor. for Sections 16, 15, 21, & 22. (SW Cor. Sec.15). **197**

Fnd - 1-1/2" I.P. w/2-1/2" B.C. (properly mkd.) Ren. #161.
BTs - 14" W.Oak bears N.45°E.,115.4-ft. visible scribe: "7 W"
8" W.Oak bears N.5°45'W.,14.6-ft. (N.4°W.) w/healed blaze.
14" D.Fir bears S.16°30'W.,20.2-ft.(S.14°30'W.) healed blaze.
New BT - 11" W.Oak bears N.0°30'E.,79.7-ft. with healed blaze. This BT was not previously of record. 5/84

Witness Corner for Sections 35 and 36 only. **198**

Found - 1924 GLO disk on a 2" I.P/ protruding 6 ins. above ground and properly marked.
(no original evidence found.)
5" now a 29" W. Oak with a well healed single blaze bears N.5°W., 27.1 ft. (per 1924 Mensch survey)
NW corner of house bears S.35 1/2°E., 196.7 ft. (Rec. 195.4 ft.) (per 1924 Mensch resurvey)
A 5/8" Iron rod protrudes 16" above ground bears East, 60 ft. (Rec. S.89°53'W.) (per M43-38) Top of I.R. bent east.
(No evidence found of barn per Mensch 1924 resurvey)

New Accessory:

The NE corner of brick chimney at 7925 Lookingglass Road bears S.51 3/4°W., 77.7 ft.

Corner is approx. 0.5 miles south of Lookingglass on the west side of Lookingglass Road. (Co. Rd. #47) (Sketch in C.S. file)

1/4 Corner for Sections 22 and 27 **199**

No monuments found. The mound of stone called by Garrett has been destroyed, presumably by construction of an east-west roadway. From position as determined by Garrett (See C.S. 55/111) which lies along S. edge of roadway:
Found - Probable original black oak is now 17" dia., with the face axed out, center decayed, is alive but in very poor condition. No scribing found, bears N. 20° W., 16.4 ft.
