1/4 Corner to Sections 19 & 30.
Found - 54" D. Fir, an original BT with old "X" (apparently originally bark scribed, scribes now not visible)
Set - 5/8" Iron Rod
Rescribe- Original 54" D. Fir; "S19 1/2 S BT" bears N 35° E, 15.2 ft.
40" Incense Cedar BT(original) with scribes visible, tree now blown down, bears S 80° E, 68.6 ft.
New BT: 60" Incense Cedar, I scribed "1/4 S S30 BT, T28S, R4W" bears S 39° W, 57.0 ft.

1/4 Corner to Sections 30-28-4 & 25-28-5.
Found - 24" Madrone, original BT with axe marks on face but scribes now rotted out, said face overgrown by wood 80+ years old, bears S 75° W 9.9 ft.
18" Madrone, probable original BT, bears N. 5° E, 87.3 ft. (record 75.9 ft).
Set - 5/8" Iron rod
New BTS: 18" D. Fir, bears N 60° W 56.3 ft. Mkd: "T28 SR 5 W S25 1/2 S BT"
32" D. Fir, bears S 38° E 24.0 ft. Mkd: "T28 SR 4 W S30 1/2 S BT"

1/4 Corner to Sections 29 & 30.
Found - 20" Cedar BT Stump (1922) scribes visible, bears S 15 1/2° W, 43.0 ft. (Ren. # 15)
1922 remains of Pine BT stump bears S 34° E 30.2 ft
Set - 5/8" iron rod
New BTs: 20" D. Fir, I scribed "S30 1/2 S BT" bears N 64° W, 109 ft.
12" D. Fir, I scribed "S29 1/2 S BT" bears N 65° E 49.7 ft.

108

1/4 Corner to Sections 30 & 31.
Found - Nothing
Set - 5/8" Iron rod by proportion.
New BTS: 10" D. Fir, I scribed "1/2 S S31 BT" bear S 9° E 139.0ft.
8" I. Cedar, I scribed "1/2 S S30 BT", bears N 81° 171.0 ft.

Center 1/4 Corner of Section 29.
Compute Center position, setting it midway between 1/4 corners, on North and South sides, and East & West sides.
Drove Iron Pipe for corner and marked:
18" Fir N. 88 1/2° W. 90.4 ft.
24" Fir S. 57 1/2° E. 52.6 ft.

dated Nov. 1, 1922

1/4 Corner to Sections 14 and 15.
Found - Brass Cap, Ren. #38, set 2" below surface of old unused portion of road.
8", now 11" Red Cedar S. 10° E. 31.5 ft., blaze nearly healed over. Stump of O. BT. to SW.
N.W. BT. taken out in new road construction.
New BT: 7" Hemlock S. 37 1/2° W. 42.7 ft. Mkd: 1/4 S15 CS BT.
Note - Since old road will be no longer used, we leave Brass Cap uncovered an incircle with rocks.
