Found - Stump of orig. N.W. BT. still in location.
1958 Cadastral Brass Cap & Pipe pushed over & buried 13" below surface.
12" Cedar, now stump & covered by logs, N. 59° E. 73.3 ft., scribe visible.
13", now 14" Cedar, alive, N. 29 3/4° W. 39.1 ft., scribe vis.
Reset - Brass Cap in proper position.
New BT: 6" Cedar N. 36 1/2° E. 136.8 ft. mkd. T27S R4W S35 CS BT.
