Found - Axle, with flange on top, at Corner. *Ren # 21*  
8" W. Oak S.  $34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 63.3 ft., shows good scar. Tree in good condition.  
5" W. Oak N.  $75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 113.5 ft., shows good scar. " " " "  
12" Bl. Oak S.  $60\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E. 59.5 ft., scribing "S" Visible. " " "  
9" Pine N.  $86^{\circ}$  E. 185.3 ft. is dead & down, scribing "BT still  
visible on stump, stump rotting badly.  
New BT: 30" Pine N.  $6^{\circ}$  E. 122.2 ft. Mkd: T27S R5W S36 CS BT.  
Note - Corner monument is approximately 6" below ground surface in

"Dodson" Bench Mark set by USC & GS in 1942 on above big Rock  
bears N.  $88^{\circ}$  E. 190.7 ft.  
A boulder, 5.0 ft. high, I scribed "X", bears S.  $45^{\circ}$  W. 353.0 ft.,  
(Record was S.  $45^{\circ}$  W. 270.6 ft.)  
A boulder, Originally 4.0 ft. high, now 2.0 ft. high, bears  
N.  $46^{\circ}$  E. 214.0 ft. (Record N.  $46^{\circ}$  E. 165.0 ft.)

40" Madrone Stump bears S.  $20^{\circ}$  E. 78.4 ft.  
20" Oak, now blown down, with face & BT tag, bears S.  $24^{\circ}$  W., 53.7 ft.  
New BTs: 20" Oak, I scribed "T28S R5W S36 BT", bears S.  $57^{\circ}$  E. 80.9 ft.  
42" Madrone, I scribed "T28S R5W S35 BT", bears S.  $63^{\circ}$  W. 87.7 ft.  
6" Madrone, I scribed "T28S R5W S26 BT", bears N.  $84^{\circ}$  W., 46.3 ft.
