14" now 36" dia. 1 ft. high Oak stump, no blazes or scribing
visible, bears N.48°W., 75.0 ft. (record N.48°W., 75.9 ft.
possible slope measurement) Ren. No. 6

8" B. oak now depression in ground bears S.25 1/2°E., 105.2 ft.
(agrees with record) Ren. No. 65

20" now 31" dia. B. Oak with a fully healed double blaze, bears
N.45°E., 1.8 ft. (agrees with record) Ren. No. 65

No other original or renewal bearing trees are found.

New BTs - 9" dia. Ash double blazed and scribed "T28S R6W S8 CS BT"
bears S.54 3/4°W., 136.8 ft.

12" dia. W. Oak double blazed and scribed "T28S R6W S9 CS BT"
bears S.9°E., 145.8 ft.

28" dia. W. Oak double blazed and scribed 'T28S R6W S5 CS BT"
bears N.19 1/2°W., 93.0 ft.
