7" R. Fir N. 4°W. 41.0 ft. scribed AP CS BT.

Angle Point (S. 38°21'W. 7.38 Chains from N. E. Cor. S6 T28-7W.
Found - Brass Cap. S. W. BT., now Stump. S.E. BT. shows scar.

New BT's: 20" Myrtle bears N. 63½°E. 40.0 ft. scribed AP CS BT.
6" W. Fir bears N. 55½°W. 42.6 ft. scribed AP CS BT.

Found - Brass Cap & Both Orig. BT's. & Eppstein's S. W. BT.

New BT's: 6" W. Oak bears N. 25°E. 29.6 ft. scribed ¼ S31 CS BT.
8" W. Oak bears N. 67½°W. 44.9 ft. scribed ¼ S31 CS BT.

North ¼ Corner Section 6, T28-7W.

Found - Brass Cap (sprout of ground). Base from Nov 24" W. O. RAN. #95

New BT: 8" R. Fir bears S. 18°E. 45.0 ft. scribed N ¼ S6 CS BT.

16" Fir Stump N. 66°E. 18.5 ft., shows scar. T27S R7W S32/S33 AP5 1924
36" Laurel N. 65°W. 26.4 ft. Alive & in good condition. Did not open.

New BT: 24" Laurel N. 39°E. 16.6 ft. Mkd: T27S R7W S33 CS BT.

Corner lies about 10 ft. west of fence corner (new fence). Fence runs E & N.

Point establish by Ford for Corner Sections 32 & 33.

Reestablished as Angle Point.

Found - Iron Pipe with Brass Cap Mkd: AB 1924.

14" Fir Stump S. 41°E. 23.1 ft., shows good scar.
8" Fir Stump S. 50°W. 7.3 ft., uprooted & lying face down. Did not look for 2 Orig. Trees.

Hathorn's Point for Standard Corner Secs. 4 & 5, renewed as Angle Point.

Found - Iron Pipe with Brass Cap Mkd: "AP 6 1924"

14" Fir Stump N. 50°E. 19.1 ft.) Both Stumps show good scar.
14" Fir Stump N. 60°W. 4.6 ft.)
30" Laurel S. 41°E. 10.6 ft., Tree now dead.

New BT's: 14" Fir S. 63½°W. 25.8 ft. Mkd: AP CS BT.

23" Fir S. 87°E. 31.6 ft. Mkd: AP CS BT.

Corner is 1 ft. North of New E. & W. Fence.

Renew Angle Point (S. 35°15'W. 5.39 Chs. from W.P. for N. ¼ Cor. Sec. 5.

Found - Brass Cap at Corner. No trace of S.W. BT. N. W. & N. E. BT's. stumps only. S. E. BT. in good condition.

New BT's: 9" R. Fir bears N. 29½°E. 26.2 ft. scribed AP CS BT.

Rescribe Orig., now 32" Laurel, bears S. 42°E. 29.3 ft.
