Found - Orig. BT's, as recorded in Ren. #5 by G.G. Stewart, 1922:

8", now 22" W. Oak, alive, N. 83 1/2*W. 48.5 ft., shows scar,
open above scar.

18", now 22" B. Oak, decayed stump, 6' high, South 35.4 ft.,
find frag. scribe & reverse on blaze nearly surrounded by
new trees.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 28 S R 7 W
(Set 3/4"x7' I.P. alongside) Office 1/4 S 3
Brass Cap for marker 1968 S 10

New BT's: 7" W. Oak S. 71* W. 31.2 ft. mkd: " 1/4 S10 CS BT.

22" W. Oak N. 83 1/2* W. 48.5 ft. mkd: " 1/4 S3 CS BT" above hole.

(This is Stewart's BT.)

Corner lies in field 30 ft. N. of old fence line S.E - N.W. following
dry creek.

Also Mkd: 36" B. Oak South 37.2 ft. mkd: "1/4 S10 CS BT". (New Tree
surrounding remains of Stewart BT)

Found - 1/2" I.P. 18" long & Orig. BT's. recorded in Ren. #15.

16", now 18" B. Oak, 14' high snag, N. 86*E. 9.8 ft., scribe
marks visible on opened blaze.

18" B. Oak, now only stub of stump & burned log remains, N. 81*W.
18.5 ft., no scribe found.

(Reset I.P. alongside) Office, 1968 N.W. D.L.C / 49

New BT's: 6" D. Fir N. 29* E. 32.8 ft. mkd: " N. W. DLC 49 CS BT.

6" D. Fir S. 13* W. 41.4 ft. mkd: "N.W. DLC 49 CS BT."

This corner lies on steep south slope densely covered with Laurel & few Fir:

Found - 3/4" I. Rod & BT's. as recorded in Ren. #13.

12", now 16" W. Oak, alive, S. 55*W. 15.0 ft. (Rec. S65W) shows
good scar. Do not open. Rescribe: "NE DLC 49 CS BT" above old scar.

6", now 15" B. Oak, alive, N. 77 1/2*E. 18.0 ft., open & find "49" scribe.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 28 S R 7 W
(Deposit old I.R. alongside) Office, 1968 N.E. D.L.C. / 49

New BT: 7" W. Oak S. 48* E. 11.0 ft. mkd: " NE DLC 49 CS BT".

This corner lies in N - S fence line about 180 ft. S. of Swan Hill Road.

Found - 1958 C. S. Brass Cap & BT's. as recorded in Ren. #12 & #116.

BT's. all sawed stumps, except 14" Pine S. 44* E. 9.3 ft.
alive, scribe visible on unhealed blaze.

New BT: 7" W. Oak N. 81* E. 9.1 ft. mkd: " S.W. Ext. L DLC 49 CS BT".

This corner lies about 400 ft. N. 45*E. of junction of highway #42
and Olalla Road on S. side Hwy. #42, in R/W. clearing area.
