Corner #7 of H. E. S. No. 141.

Found - Old Corner Stone, in place, broken, mkd: "+" on top and "7 HES 141" on South Side.

Orig. 28", now 30" Fir, dead Snag, N. 44 3/4° E. 55.4 ft., scribe visible on unhealed blaze.

Orig. 8", now 18" Fir, alive, N. 78° W. 4.3 ft., shows good scar. We Rescribe "7 HES 141 CS BT".

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
(Reset Stone Alongside) Office, 1969 Cor. #7 HES 141

New BT: 36" Cedar N. 34° E. 31.0 ft. mkd: "7 HES 141 CS BT".

This corner lies on N. side of roadway into claim at top of cut bank.

Corner #8 of H. E. S. No. 141.

Found - Old Corner Stone, buried, mkd: "+" on top & "8 HES 141 on South.

Orig. 15", now 18" W. Fir Snag, N. 88° W. 42.2 ft., shows scar.

Orig. 12", now 16" W. Fir Snag, N. 39 1/4° W. 41.6 ft., open & "H" scribe visible.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
(Reset Stone Alongside) Office, 1969 Cor. #8 HES 141

New BT's: 10" Yew S. 87° W. 55.1 ft. mkd: "8 HES 141 CS BT".

18" Maple N. 69° W. 22.5 ft. mkd: "8 HES 141 CS BT".

This corner lies on flat. Corner No. 16 of same claim bears N. 52° E. 41.9'.

Corner #9 of H. E. S. No. 141.

Found - No trace of Old Corner Stone.

Orig. 24", now 32" Fir Stump, S. 58 3/4° E. 82.5 ft., open & find "BT".

Other Orig. BT. pushed out of place about 50 ft. by cat., scribe visible.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
Office, 1969 Cor. #9 HES 141

New BT's: 20" Maple N. 78° W. 12.0 ft. mkd: "9 HES 141 CS BT".

20" Cedar S. 44° E. 62.5 ft. mkd: "9 HES 141 CS BT".

This corner lies on South Side of old road, Corner #15 of same survey bears N. 55° E. 42.5 ft.

Corner #10 of H. E. S. 141.

Found - Old Corner Stone, in place, mkd: "+" on top & "10 HES 141" on side.

Orig. 36", now 48" Fir, alive but dying, S. 76° W. 13.9 ft., shows scar, We tag.

Orig. S. E. BT., down, scar visible.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
Office, 1969 Cor. #10 HES 141

New BT's: 8" W. Fir S. 68° E. 6.1 ft. mkd: "10 HES 141 CS BT".

8" W. Fir N. 1° E. 12.0 ft. mkd: "10 HES 141 CS BT".

Corner #14, same survey, bears N. 2° W. 36.3 ft. (Rec. N 6° 21' W 32.0 ft.)

Corner #11 of H. E. S. No. 141.

Found - Stump of Orig. 18" (?), now 20" Ash Corner Tree, opened on south side, scribe visible.

Orig. 26", now 32" Fir, alive, N. 9 1/4° E. 31.7 ft., shows very good scar, Tag.

Orig. 6", now 14" W. Fir, alive, N. 67 3/4° E. 20.5 ft., faint scar.

We Rescribe "11 HES 141 CS BT".

Set at a point 1.2 ft. south of center of Corner Stump,

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
Office, 1969 Cor. #11 HES 141

This corner lies at bottom of hill about 20 ft. north of Deadman Creek.

Found - Hole where old Corner Tree stood.

Orig. 16", now 30" W. Fir, alive, S. 3 1/2° E. 17.2 ft., shows scar, we tag.

Orig. 16", now 28" W. Fir Stump, S. 37 1/2° W. 22.4 ft., we open & find scribe.

Set - Brass Cap at Cor. Mkd: County Surveyor's T 29 S R 2 W  
Office, 1969 Cor. #12 HES 141

New BT; 12" W. Fir S. 57° W. 24.0 ft. mkd: "12 HES 141 CS BT".

This corner lies on flat near foot of mountain.
