Found old witness tree 30" Black Oak S.25°E. 238.26 ft.
Set $\frac{3}{4}$ " Gal. I. Pipe with mound of rock.
Scribed new witness tree, 26" White Oak N.46°48'W. 42.1 Ft. 81

SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 22-23-26-27. 2
Found 12" White Oak (now 26") N.6°W. 231.0 ft.

Take for witness point South end of concrete pier on East
side of North Myrtle Creek, S.85°11'W. 32.0 ft. SEE Ren. #55
North end of the above pier N.52°23'W. 38.2 Ft.

SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 21-22-27-28. 4
Run line East, West and North and from different points in
City of Myrtle Creek at point of intersection set Iron Axle
shaft with Gear on top for corner, all old witness trees
gone. Record 4 new trees as follows,

30" Maple N.36°08'E. 133.8 Ft. Not Scribed.
34" Black Oak S. 82° 46'W. 200.6 Ft. Not Scribed.

Find 8" White Oak S.38°E. 73.92 Ft also Stump of tree
