Large rock set by new Government survey from which
A Madrone 18" dia. bears N.76 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 58 lks.
A Fir 18" dia. bears S.31°E., 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks.
A Fir 12" dia. bears S.20 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W., 49 lks.
A Fir 24" dia. bears N.19 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 17 lks.

✓ $\frac{1}{2}$ CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 19 and 30. 59
Large rock set by New Government survey from which
A Madrone 30" dia. bears S. 4°E., 32 lks.
A Madrone 12" dia. bears N.72 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. 161

✓ SECTION CORNER 1, 2, 11 and 12. 60
Reestablished. Found Black Oak stump marked B.T. Facing N.E. Recognized as B.T. described S.65°W., 62 lks. Other trees obliterated. Measured N.65°E., 62 links and set stake marked C.S. Buried 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" x 8" Iron Plate. Marked
A White Oak 14" dia. N.71°15'W., 182
A White Oak 32" dia. S.53°30'W., 454
A Black Oak 32" dia. S. 6°00'E., 375
A Black Oak 22" dia. N.18°30'E., 342

✓ $\frac{1}{2}$ CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 and 22. 61
Reestablished from original two B.T.s which are badly decayed and hollow. Set 5/8" Iron Bolt 36" long, nut on top, beside 15" White Fir which is blazed. Marked following two trees
A 24" Fir (bark blaze) N.44 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 18.0'
A 8" Fir S. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 25.5'

✓ S.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. 41 (STEPHEN WILLIS) 62
Reestablished from stump of original Oak B.T. Set Ford rear axle shaft, pinion gear attached, from which, 220
A 24" Cedar bears S.35°W., 43.2 ft. near R. bank creek
A 22" W. Fir bears S.5°E., 47.3 ft. near R. bank creek

✓ N.E. CORNER OF LOT 3, WHICH IS ALSO N.W. CORNER OF LOT 2. 63
N.E. corner of lot 3, which is also N.W. corner of Lot 2, Section 15 as agreed to in signed statement by the two (all) interested property owners: Victor Phipps and Kittie Wilcox. Set 1" x 30" Auto axle from which
A 8" Fir marked C.S.B.T. bears N.54°W., 16.0 ft.
A 6" Myrtle marked C.S.B.T. bears S.54 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 6.8 ft.
On hill side about 100 ft. W. of county road.

✓ CENTER SECTION 15. 64
This point is set on the N. and S. mid-section line only and all property owners affected have signed agreement on approval. Set 1" steel Auto Axle from which
A 18" Ash bears N.72°E., 12.5 ft.
A 12" Myrtle bears N.45°E., 32.0 ft.
Axle is driven about 60 ft. south of creek.

✓ NORTH $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 2 (SOUTH $\frac{1}{4}$ COR. OF 35 28/6) 65
Conglomerate rock set from original "Y" Oak stump hole which is S.72 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 396 lks. and from fallen dead "Y" Oak N.13 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 306 lks. New trees properly blazed and scribed.
A 10" White Oak N. 8°E., 57.5 ft. marked C.S.B.T.
A 12" White Oak S.34°45'E., 66 ft. marked C.S. B.T.
