A 10" Fir now 15", bears N.38 1/2°E., 78.5 ft. Healed over blaze.
A 10" Fir now 13", bears S.41 1/2°E., 58.1 ft. with healed blaze.
A 17" Fir now 21", bears S.88°W., 107.6 ft. with healed blaze.
Note: Found unrecorded 19" Fir stump bears N.19 1/2°E., 23.2 ft. visible scribing "BT".
A fence corner bears N.77°E., 1 ft. Said fence runs easterly and southerly.

1/4 Corner for Secs. 16 and 17.

Found OK

Found - 1954 County brass cap properly marked. Ren. #63

Cap is approx. 1 foot above ground.

✓ A R. Fir 20" now 30" bears N.41°W., 16.5 ft. to face, 18.0 ft. to center. (Orig. N.46°E., renewal rec. N.46°W.). Tree has prev. opened blaze. Scribe visible "BT".

✓ A B. Oak 12" 'now 17" bears N.21°W., 17.8 ft. Tree has well healed double blaze.

✓ A B. Oak 6" now 10" bears N.39°E., 26.6 ft. Tree has well healed double blaze.

Found remains of rotted Fir stump bears N.46°E., 19.5 ft. (rec. 19.0 ft.) No scribing found.

Note: Cap is approx 1.2 ft. southerly of a fence running generally east and west.

S W 1/16 Corner for Sec. 18 (AP 4 Tr. 51 and AP 1 Tr. 52)

Found - 1924 GLO brass cap with 1" I.P. 8 1/2° above ground properly mkd.
A 12" Fir now a 15" Fir snag bears N.39°W., 13.2 ft. Healed over blaze. We chopped into Fir found scribing "BT".

A 24" Black Oak down and rotted bears S.83°W., 13.2 ft. No visible scribing.

New BT's- A 10" D. Fir bears S.74°E., 22.5 ft. scribed "SW 1/16 S18 CS BT" in double blaze.

A 6" Ponderosa Pine, bears S.34°W., 15.9 ft. scribed "AP 1 Tr. 52 CS BT" in double blaze.

West 1/16 Cor. Sec. 18 and AP 4, Tr. 50 and AP 1 Tr. 51

Found - 1" I.P. with brass cap, GLO survey 192 marked. (We could not read the year digit) Should read 1924. Brass cap is 7" above ground, 8 ft. East of dry channel in clearcut, 50 ft. South of tree line.

Remains of Maple stump bears S.29 1/2°W., 42.9 ft. Size indeterminate. No scribing found.

A 26" Fir stump bears N.22°W., 31.5 ft. (Rec. N.25°W., 49 lks.) Opened healed over blaze, found scribing "AP 4 Tr 50 BT".

New BT's- A 9" D. Fir bears S.81°W., 29.2 ft. double blazed and marked "AP 1 Tr 51 S18 CS BT".

A 24" Incense Cedar bears N.62 1/2°E., 58.2 ft. Double blazed and marked "CW 1/16 S18 CS BT".

Found - 5/8" I. Rod firmly set, extending 4" above ground on a steep and brushy NE slope above Olalla Creek. See M 28-69

A 24" now 20" D. Fir, alive with well healed double blaze bears S.23°E., 46.0 ft.

An 18" now 17" G. Fir, alive with well healed double blaze bears N.66°W., 27.5 ft. (Rec. N.64°W., 27.5 ft.)
