Orig. 60" Fir, now stump, N. 28° E. 38.3 ft., butnt cat face.  
10", now 11" (12' Snag) N. 82° E. 59.4 ft., scribe visible.  
26", now 29" Hemlock (Record D.Fir) S. 53° E. 40.9 ft.  
14", now 20" Hemlock S. 66½° W. 73.9 ft., scribe visible,  
tree is rotting.  
8", now 18" Hemlock, N. 46° W. 37.0 ft., shows good scar.
