- ✓ 1/4 CORNER ON EAST SIDE OF SECTION 25. **SEE CORNER NO. 22** 1
 A 1 1/2" Pipe from which
 An Oak 12" in dia. N. 39° W., 451 lks.
 An Ash 8" in dia. S. 77° E., 2 lks.

- ✓ CORNER TO SECTIONS 30-31-25-26. 2
 Drive Iron Pipe 2" dia. 36" long beside old Corner
 stake from which
 A Stump of White Oak N. 75 1/2° W., 382 lks.
 Old B.T. White Oak N. 75° E., 86 lks.
 Old B.T. White Oak S. 68° W., 319 lks.
 No trace of other B.T. **SEE CORNER NO. 70**

- ✓ 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 25 and 36. 3
 Renew Corner from remains of old B.T.s. Set Iron
 Pipe 1 1/2" dia. from which **SEE CORNER NO. 60**
 A Fir 26" in dia. S. 72 1/2° W., 59 lks.
 A Fir 16" in dia. N. 7° 15' E., 60 lks.

- ✓ CORNER TO SECTIONS 25, 26, 36 and 39. **SEE CORNER NO. 20** 4
 Set 2" Iron Pipe beside old corner stake. Original
 B.T.s standing.

- ✓ 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 25 and 26. 5
 Set Iron Pipe 2" x 36". No evidence of old corner.
 No trees near for bearing trees.

- ✓ CORNER TO SECTIONS 24, 23, 25 and 26. 6
 Set Iron Pin 1" x 36" with 2" Iron Pipe. No evidence
 of old corner. No suitable trees near.

- ✓ 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 24 and 25. 7
 Set 1 1/4" Iron Pipe. No suitable trees near. Point
 checks from Original B.T. which is dead but scribe
 marks still show.

- ✓ CORNER TO 24 and 25, and 19 and 30. **SEE CORNER NO. 24** 8
 Rock, buried beneath surface, containing 2,000 cubic
 inches, marked with X on top. Remains of old B.T. to
 N.E.

- ✓ 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 26 and 35. **SEE CORNER NO. 28** 9
 Set a 1" x 30" pipe from which
 An Oak 10" in dia. bears N. 1° 00' W., 10.5 ft.
 An Oak 12" in dia. bears N. 89° 00' W., 13.0 ft. **SEE ALSO # 21**
 Set from remains of old B.T., N.E.

- ✓ S.W. CORNER OF CLAIM # 44. 10
 Set 1" x 30" iron pipe from which
 Original B.T. N. 75° E., 63 lks.
 Marked
 A 10" Fir S. 47° W., 17 lks.

- ✓ 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 26 and 27. **SEE CORNER NO. 63** 11
 Set 1" x 30" iron pipe from which
 A Cedar 10" in dia. bears N. 62° E., 14.5 ft.
 A Fir 20" in dia. bears N. 61° 15' W., 16 ft.
 Old stake standing but badly decayed. Cedar B.T.
 had been cut but stump remains.
