- 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Between Secs. 25 & 26  
W. Oak 12" bears N. 30° W. 97.0 Feet  
Fir 36" " S. 75° E. 303.7 "
- 2 RESET  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER ON LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 27 and 28.  
One old Government witness tree in evidence. Quarter corner is Sand stone 4" x 8" x 24" marked S. from which  
A Maple 13" dia. bears S. 30° 30' E. 32.4 ft. 112  
A Maple 10" dia. bears S. 67° 00' W., 15.0 ft.  
Trees are marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. 27 and  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. 28.
- 3 RESET  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER ON LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 28 and 29.  
One old Government tree in evidence. Quarter Corner is White Porphyry Stone 9" x 10" x 20" from which  
A Black Oak 6" dia. bears S. 2° 30' W. 155.1 ft. #134  
A Maple 12" dia. bears N. 7° 25' W. 176.3 ft.  
A Red Fir 36" dia. bears N. 15° 00' E., 148.5 ft. Original tree  
U.S.G.S.B.M. Elevation 911 S. 82° 40' E., 28.2 ft.  
Trees are marked according to the Statute.
- 4 RESET "L" CORNER OF CLIAM 37.  
Set per old B.T.s. Set in a 2" x 36" G.I.P., from which  
A 12" alder bears S. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 0.74 ch. Cl. 37 C.S.B.T.
- 5 N.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. NO. 37.  
Renew from old B.T.s. Set in a 2" x 30" cast Iron Pipe, from which  
Old Government trees marked still stand. 58 4-A
- CORNER SECTIONS 26, 27, 34 and 35.  
Renewed with Fir post from which  
A Pine 14" bears S. 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 131 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks.  
A White Oak 16" bears S. 24° W., 252 lks.  
A Cedar 12" bears N. 80° W., 170 lks.  
A Pine 42" bears N. 32° E., 179 lks.  
A White Oak 14" bears S. 10° W., 26.8 ft.  
Mound of rock. 135
- 6 RESET  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER BETWEEN 30 and 31.  
Found yew post scribed "1". B.T.s gone. Location pointed out by V. W. Poole. Set Iron Pipe for corner marked new B.T.s  
A 16" Maple N. 69° W., 41.6 ft.  
A 30" Fir S. 45° E., 60.0 ft.  
Note: Found as noted--Original B.T.s, one burned out other down and rotting. Check okay.

- 7 S.E. CORNER OF D.L.C. 38. (SOUTH S.E. COR.)  
Set from old Bearing Trees. Set a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24" Iron Pipe. Marked new bearing trees as follows  
A 24" Fir S. 10° E., 18 ft.  
A 20" Fir S. 75° 30' E., 17 ft. 146
- 8 S.W. CORNER OF D.L.C. 38.  
Set from Old Bearing Trees. Set 4" x 4" x 36" Yew Wood Post and marked following Bearing Trees  
A 14" Fir S. 85° W., 82.2 ft.  
A 30" Fir S 88° 30' E., 243 ft.
