An 18" Black Oak S.85°W., 38.5 ft.

- ✓ SECTION CORNER BETWEEN 18, 19 and 22. 13  
*closing Sec. Cor.*  
Reset from stump of original B.T., others gone. Set Iron Pipe for corner.  
A 12" Black Oak bears N.63°W., 68.3 ft.  
A 12" White Oak S.72°W., 25.0 ft.  
An 18" White Oak N.42°E., 72.5 ft.  
A 12" White Oak S.69°E., 220.0 ft.

- ✓  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER BETWEEN 21 and 22. 14  
Found O.B.T. Set an Iron Pipe 4" in ground in Orchard. **SEE CORNER NO. 102**

A 8" Prune tree S.71 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 14.0 ft.  
A 8" Prune Tree N.62°E., 31.0 ft.

- ✓ SECTION CORNER BETWEEN 14, 15, 22 and 23. *SEE ALSO #7* 15  
Reset from 4 original B.T.s. Two of which have been cut but markings still legible on stump and two are alive and blaze rotted off. There is a 12" x 12" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above ground fence post reputed to have been set on corner several years ago. Set 1" Auto Axle alongside. *New 183*
