12" D.Fir, now stump, S. 13° E. 22.0 ft., no scribing found on burnt face.
8" Laurel N. 18° E. 18.0 ft., no scribing on face.

16" W. Oak, now stump, S. 17 1/2° W. 58.1 ft., shows good scar.
16" W. Oak, now stump, N. 75° W. 205.3 ft.
