Found - 6"x6"x8" S. S. with "X" on top at corner. See Ren. # 1.
12" Fir, rotted stump, N. 52° E. 12.0 ft. about 4" high, no scribe,
probably remains of original BT.
72", now 84" Fir Stump S. 46° W. 12.9 ft., shows "S7 1/2 S BT", rescribed
by Boyer, Stump is 7.0 ft. high.
60" Fir Stump N. 38° E. 27.3 ft. (to face), shows "1/4 S6 CS BT".

16" Sugar Pine S. 54 1/2° E. 11.8 ft. shows "1/2 S 34 RE274LBT", good condtn.

about 40 to 50 ft.
Note - The corner is about 150 ft. West of the Creek.

Note - This corner is about 30 ft. North of an old cat road
and near the top of a steep east slope.
